When is the event? *October 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th 2025*

How much are tickets? *\$125 per person*

Can I just go to the dance? *Absolutely! The weekend is yours to enjoy however you like. The ticket price remains \$125.*

Why are the tickets \$125? *Compared to most ticketed events, this reunion is actually a **great** value! We had hoped fundraising would help offset costs, but support was lower than expected. If just half of our Facebook members had purchased one raffle ticket, we'd be offering \$85 tickets today. It was a missed opportunity, but it's also a lesson learned. We're still proud to offer a full weekend of connection, entertainment, and memories for the cost of a single concert ticket.*

Why 4 days of events? *Because the dance alone can't hold everyone—literally. It's limited seating. And those of us who stepped up to plan this didn't want a celebration that excluded anyone. With over 2,000 members in our community, we're not planning for just 20%—we're creating something for everyone. That means a full weekend of activities, events, and experiences designed to welcome and include all who want to join.*

Why isn't there a discount if I only want to go to one event? *We simply don't have the volunteer power to manage customized tickets for each person. And yes, your ticket helps fund the entire weekend experience—but even if you only attend the dance and take home your keepsake t-shirt, you're still receiving 80% of the ticket's value... and keeping 100% of the joy.*

What does my Weekend Pass include?

- *Official Reunion T-shirt.*
- *Entry to the Meet n Greet which includes a welcome gift, food & refreshments.*
- *Entry to the Emerald Ball Friday Formal, catered by Big Meechies with DJ Keith Long playing song favorites across the decades.*
- *Entry to the Trojan game Saturday with tailgate area privileges (This portion of your ticket supports the school.)*
- *4 Kid activity passes (\$20 Value) for the Block Party! Use for your kids, grandkids or give them away.*
- ***A heart with no regret, full of memories you won't forget!***

How do I get my ticket? *Keep your emailed receipt as proof of purchase! Tickets will be included in your welcome packet.*

Which events do not require a ticket?

The Saturday Family Day Parade, the Sunday Morning School Tour & the All Community Worship Service do not require a ticket. Worship service has seating for 250 people and is first come, first served.

How do I get my t-shirt? *T-shirts will be available for pick up at the Meet n Greet on Thursday evening as part of your Welcome package. Additional opportunities to pick up your t-shirt will be announced that weekend.*

Who is catering the dance? *We will be dining on delicious food made with love from Big Meechies!*

What if I am vegan/vegetarian? *We will make sure you have a delicious meal as well, just let us know you would like a vegan plate.*

How can I be a vendor at the Block Party? *We have 60 spots with some exclusivities and filling up quickly. If you want to have a booth, please see our vendor tab located on this website.*

How can I help? *Volunteers are needed! Help staff the events, especially Thursday and Friday, help decorating the parade float, and the dance event (plus you'll get a sneak peek!), and we still need ushers and are accepting more choir participants. - *Additional expenses: insurance, printing, rentals, entertainment, decorations, signage, software, payment processing, and waste management*
