## WINTER COAT PROGRAM

PVEN's Clothing Closet, along with help from West End Rotary, was able to distribute coats and personal care products for 72 families with 170 children. Each child received a coat purchased by the Rotary through Operation Warm. Our clothing closet team was also able to pack bags of personal care products, feminine hygiene bags, and household items for each family participating.

Here's a breakdown of the distribution:

- 170 coats
- 1268 clothing items
  - (each child received 2 pairs of socks, 2 pairs of underwear, hats, gloves, boot socks and Christmas socks, snow pants, and other items as available)
- 1276 personal care products
- 79 assortment bags of feminine hygiene products
- 462 household products (laundry detergent, TP, paper towels, facial tissues, assorted cleaning products)
