

Supplies needed:

Piece of paper 8x11 ½ or larger (for family of 4 or more) Brown, green, red, yellow, and purple paint Paint brushes Dishes of water to clean the brushes

- 1. Paint the littlest hand first. Paint the palm and thumb brown, and each finger a different color. Put their hand on the far left or far right side of the paper.
- 2. Paint the next size hand the same way, paint the palm and thumb brown. Put a different color on each finger. Put this hand next to the littlest handprint.
- 3. Continue with the next size hand. Paint the same way as above. Continue until all hands are on the page.
- 4. Give the turkey legs, beak, eyes, and its wattle under its chin.
- 5. You can use black paint to put your first initial on your turkey print.
- 6. To make leaves, dip your finger in the color it was before and put fingerprint leaves on your page.
- 7. Where there is room, you can add a tree, sun, birds, or other things.
- 8. Do not forget to sign and date your masterpiece!
- 9. Let it dry before you hang on the refrigerator.
- 10. Or you can trace each hand and color it with marker or crayons, for a less messy alternative. Add the tree, sun, birds and leaves using markers and crayons.
