

Bible Challenge 3 : Jesus Calls His Disciples

Supplies:

- Two 8 ½ x 11 notebooks (spiral notebooks work—nonspiral may be a little easier)

Instructions:

1. Place the notebooks on a flat surface with the nonbound 11-inch sides facing one another.
2. Open both to the back covers and completely overlap the back covers.
3. Now overlap the pages, alternating the pages, one over the other, until the notebooks are completely intertwined. They do not need to lie perfectly flat.
4. Close the front covers.
5. Find a friend and each of you, using both hands to hold onto the spiral/bound side of one of the notebooks, try to pull them apart.
6. You should be able to pull quite hard! The notebooks will stay intertwined.

Lesson connection:

After Jesus died, rose, and went into heaven, the disciples may have felt alone. Sometimes we feel alone. But we are not alone! Jesus promised His disciples and us that even though we can't see Him, He is with us always! Just like the two notebooks cannot be pulled apart, nothing can take you away from your Savior, Jesus. You are never alone! He is always with you. He promised!
