- Apply thinset to walls, and floors.
- Utilize tools such as hammers, chisels, trowels, putty knives, power grinders, and polishers.
- Apply base of mortar to floor.
- Mix grout and apply as directed.
- Smooth and polish edges with polisher.
- Cutting and fastening underlayment/wall board as needed.
- Clean up job site.
