

CAM – Costs State/Counties Less than Jail (Savings/10 Offenders/year*)

Jail Cost/Inmate	CAM/Day	Savings/ 10 Offenders/yr
\$50/Day	\$12/Day	\$134,200
\$75/Day	\$12/Day	\$225,450
\$100/Day	\$12/Day	\$316,700

*Assumes County/State pays CAM Fees (\$75/install, \$12/day monitored)

CAM vs Jail – Side by Side

	CAM	Jail
Cost/Offender	\$12/day, \$75/install	\$50+/day
County staffing	No	Yes
Medical liability	No	Yes
Foster care	Less likely	More likely
Offender behavior “deteriorates”	Less likely	Highly likely
Offender fully employed.	Possible	Not possible
Substance Abuse Treatment	Easier to provide, more effective	Difficult to administer, should continue post- release

Other Criminal Justice Cost Considerations

- Est. Jail Construction Cost/bed - \$60,000 per bed
- Intensive Probation - \$16.53/day
- CJPP - \$15.03/day

- CAM Costs - \$75/installation
- \$12/monitored day
