"We started the HAW 5 foundation after we lost Henry in a boating accident, and rather than rely on donations, we decided the best way to keep the foundation going was to fund it ourselves through proceeds from real estate transactions," Wise says. "So Laura and I, who had been on a real estate team together for five years, decided to open Wise Living Real Estate in January 2018, six months after Henry's accident."



Wise Living Real Estate has closed over \$100 million in transactions since it began, and a portion of every transaction goes to the foundation.

"Every day, I get to get up list and sell a piece of property and make one more contribution, whether that's sending a mother and son to JH Ranch in California, sponsoring a teenager's spring break mission trip to Honduras, sending a kid to YoungLife Camp or writing a check to a family after they experience something similar to what we went through," Wise says.
