
Bible Connection Groups During Lent

LENTEN SERMON SERIES: THE WALK

How do we walk with Christ—daily follow him, grow in him, and faithfully serve him? Jesus modeled for us the Christian spiritual life. His earliest followers taught it in their writings. And the Church has, through the last 2,000 years, sought to pursue this Christian spiritual life.

On March 1 we begin our Lenten emphasis with a series entitled *The Walk*. It is taken straight from the pages of a book of the same name by Rev. Adam Hamilton. It focuses on five essential spiritual practices that are rooted in Jesus' own walk with God and taught throughout the New Testament. Each of these practices is meant to be part of our daily walk with Christ while also being an essential part of growing together in the church.

Let's deepen our walk with Christ together in these ways, as we explore the five essential practices of worship, study, serving, giving, and bearing witness to our faith.

THE WALK CHALLENGE

Worship together each week.
Give thanks at least
5 times each day.
Read at least 5 verses
of the Bible each day.
Pursue 5 acts
of kindness each week.
Practice 5 acts of generosity
toward others each month.
Invite 5 people to church
with you each year.

Finance Report

As we look back on 2019, we accomplished a lot. First, we paid the entire amount \$19,004 of our connectional mission giving for the first time in several years; and second, we were able to pay for parking lot repairs - which were badly needed. The Finance team had set a strict budget for 2019 and we were able to finish the year under budget by \$4,632.00. None of this would have been obtainable without YOU, all the members of First United Methodist Church of Watauga. Without your pledges, contributions, prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness, it may not have happened. Thanks for all you do!

Rev. Sheila and the Finance team want to thank all volunteers that made 2019 a success.

Your Finance team has set and passed an achievable Budget for 2020, which increased by about \$14,000; and has been approved by the Ad Board. The increased budget consists of a 3% raise for the staff and line items that we have always paid for, but were not in the actual budget. The line items include our web page, fire alarm inspections, and others. So far, we have paid \$4,000 dollars of our connectional mission giving of \$18,942 for 2020.

The Lord is growing and working in our church. Let us take the light outside the walls and let it shine. God bless and guide you and your family throughout the year!
