Thomas Two was born on 20 Jul 1729 in St Andrew Holborn, London, England, and died in Mar 1772 in Marston, Bedfordshire, England. He is the son of Richard Two and Ann Wells. He married Elizabeth Battin on 23 Jul 1758 in Marston Moretaine, Bedfordshire, England. She was born in Abt 1745 in Marston, Bedfordshire, England, and died in abt 1840 in Marston, Bedfordshire, England.

20 Jul 1729, Birth and Baptism St Andrew Holborn, London, England. NOTE: His name in the register entry is rendered as Thomas Tow, having been altered from Tew, and the Bishops transcripts read as Tow. Thomas came from London.

23 July 1758 Marriage to Elizabeth Battin Marston Moretaine, Bedfordshire, England

Dear Mr. Jackson,
Thank you for your e-mail of 17 March. A quick check in the parish register transcripts for Marston Moreteyne shows that Thomas Two married Ann Wells on 11 March 1811. I note also that the baptism for John Two in that same parish is recorded as 24 December 1820, pre-dating the year you note for his birth.

Actual text: Thomas, son of James and Mary Tew (one of the spelling variants of the name, including Too and Tow) was baptised in Marston on 18 October 1789. James Two married Mary Dicks on 21 November 1788 (also at Marston), and was baptised in Marston on 20 December 1767, son of Thomas and Elizabeth Two. They in turn had married in Marston on 23 July 1758 (she was Elizabeth Battin; his name in the register entry is rendered as Thomas Tow, having been altered from Tew, and the Bishop's Transcript reads 'Tow'). Thomas came from London, baptised 20 July 1729 at Holborn, son of Richard and Ann Two, so matters become more impenetrable from there. My colleague, Ms. Laura Johnson, descends from the other surviving child of John Two and Phoebe Cook, so if you have further questions, you might wish to direct them to her attention via this same e-mail address.
