

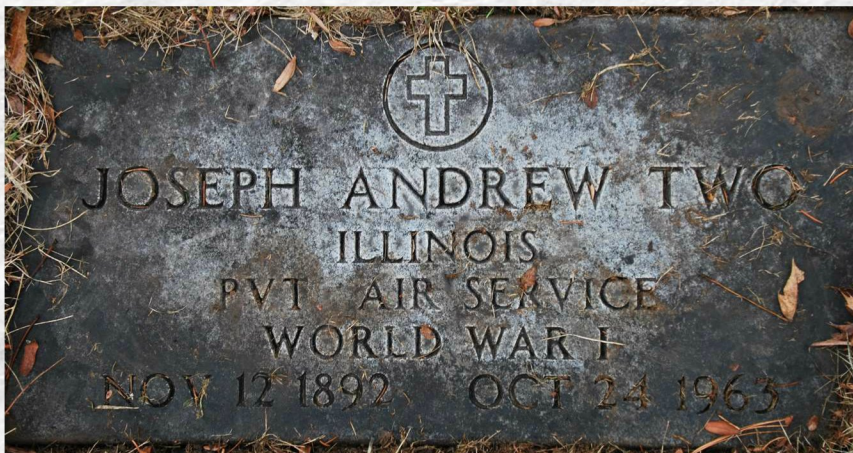

Surviving are five children, Joseph, Jr., Fred, Mrs. Haley, and Mrs. Rose Brush, all of Rockford, and Mrs. Bessie Brown of Chicago.

A funeral service will be held on Tuesday at 9:30 a. m. at the Haley home. Burial will take place in the Catholic cemetery.



Effie "Mary" Hester Moore was born on 16 Dec 1893 in Greene County, Tennessee, and died on 1 Jan 1981 in 90240 Downey, Los Angeles, California, USA. She is the daughter of John C Moore and Lurinda J Price. She married Joseph Andrew Two in abt 1915 in Rockford , Winnebago County, Illinois, USA. He was born on 12 Nov 1893 in Winnebago County, Illinois, and died on 24 Oct 1963 in Village of Shorewood Hills, Dane County, Madison, WI. He is the son of Joseph Andrew Two and Margaret Russell.

EFFIE "MARY" HESTER MOORE - *Individual Timeline*

18 Jun 1900 Per the 1900 Federal Census, residence is Civil District 7, Greene, TN. No street number or name is provided. States Effie was born about Jan 1893 and is living with her father John born Apr 1852, mother Lurinda born Mar 1853, brother Robert born May 1881, brother John born Aug 1884, sister Rebecca born Feb 1886, sister Eliza born Dec 1888, brother William born May 1890, and brother Wilbur born Apr 1898.

7 May 1910 Per the 1910 Federal Census, residence is Civil District 7, Greene, TN. No street number or name provided. Shows Effie as 18 yrs of age and living with her father John age 55, mother Lurinda age 51, brother Samuel age 14, brother Wilbur age 11 and a niece Nellie age 11.

1915 About - Marriage to Joseph Andrew Two. Per his WWI registration card, which is dated June 5, 1917, he is married with one child. This child would be his first born son Joseph Andrew Two Jr. who was born in 1916 and died in 1917. Based on this information I am guessing that they were married about 1915.

7 Jan 1920 Per the 1920 Federal Census she is living with many others at 314 Kent Street in Rockford, IL. I believe this is a boarding house and she is there without her husband.

4 Jul 1920 Per newspaper article, she and Joseph are seeking a divorce. Not sure when the divorce was granted.

28 Apr 1924 Marriage to William A Lewis at the parsonage of the Winnebago Street M.E. Church by Rev. Clyde King. She was living at 1027 S. Main St. and William was living at 630 Rome Ave. in Rockford.

24 Apr 1930 Per the 1930 Federal Census she, her husband and children are residing at 630 Rome Ave., Rockford, IL. She is 34 yrs of age, husband William is age 43, son Robert W is age 17, daughter Olga C is age 16, daughter Evelyn M is age 12 and daughter Byrdie is age 4.

1 Apr 1940 Per the 1940 Federal Census Effie is age 45 and Widowed. She is the head of the household. Her son William Two, age 21, from her first marriage is living with her as well as her daughter Byrdie age 14 and a cousin also named Effie Moore age 38 at 630 Rome Ave., Rockford, IL

22 Nov 1941 Marriage to Frank Berg per her husband Frank's obituary. His obit states that he is survived by a daughter Carol whose married name is McWilliams. This could be a daughter from a previous marriage other than to Effie.
