**DEATH CLAIMS**  
**C. C. SCHLENK**  
 Former Resident Of  
 Rockford Dies In  
 St. Louis

Funeral services for Clement C. Schlenk, former resident of Rockford, who died at St. Luke's hospital in St. Louis, Mo., will be held Thursday morning at St. James Pro-cathedral at an hour to be announced later.

Mr. Schlenk was born in Rockford, the son of George and the late Mary A. Schlenk, and attended St. James parochial school and Rockford high school. He left Rockford about 23 years ago and at the time of his death was employed by the Union Electric and Gas company of St. Louis, where he was in charge of the sales and accounting departments. His home was at 6722 Crest avenue in University City, Mo.

Surviving are his widow, the former Arvilla Corcoran of Rockford; two daughters, Mrs. Richard Dittman of Tallahassee, Fla., and Mrs. William Two of Rockford; two sons, George J., attending the army medical center at Walter Reed hospital, Washington, D. C., and John C. Schlenk, of St. Louis; his father, George L. Schlenk of Rockford; a brother, Clyde of Benton Harbor, Mich., and three sisters, Mrs. John McNamara and Miss Oleen Schlenk, both of Rockford, and Miss Doreen Schlenk of Milwaukee, Wis.
