Introduction

These are the abstracts of two sections of the report handed in on November 3rd, 2020: “Giovanni Lombardo’s family” and “Angela Marino’s family”. They are updated with the new information collected during this research session. The new details are reported in [blue](#). When the number of the birth record of reference appears, the details associated to it have been found in decennial indexes and there are no documents attached about it.

Giovanni Lombardo’s family

Giuseppe Lombardo and Rosaria Maria Patt had seven children, six of whom got to adulthood:

1) Leonardo, named after the paternal grandfather, was born on February 25th, 1864, just north of the walled city, outside *porta Trapani*, the gate heading to that city. Leonardo got married in Marsala on April 19th, 1896 with Vincenza Abate. As reported by the client, the couple had two children before emigrating to the USA. I could document only one of them, Vita. Instead, I could not find any reference to Giuseppa. In addition, I could document another child born later:

1.1) Vita Lombardo, born on October 20th, 1898, got married in the States with Giuseppe Giacalone and had several children.

1.2) Rosaria Lombardo, born on November 5th, 1903.

2) Francesco, named after the maternal grandfather, was born on December 8th, 1866 in *via San Francesco*. He got married with Caterina Ampola when he was almost 40 years old, on September 8th, 1906 in Marsala. I could document [six children for this couple](#):

2.1) Rosaria (I) Lombardo, born in Petrosino on October 2nd, 1907 and dead there six weeks later, on November 18th, 1907 (docs.2-3L).

2.2) Rosaria (II) Lombardo, born in *via C. Isgro* in Marsala on March 19th, 1909, got married on December 26th, 1934 with Pietro Curatolo (doc.4L). I could document four children of theirs:

2.2.1) Pietro Curatolo, born on June 19th, 1937 in Petrosino (N.105/1937 Petr.). In 1986, when he reported her mother’s death, he still resided in Petrosino (doc.5L).

2.2.2) Francesco Curatolo, born on March 25th, 1940 in Santo Padre delle Perriere (N.16/1940 S.P.P.).

2.2.3) Caterina Curatolo, born on April 20th, 1943 in Santo Padre delle Perriere and dead in Strasatti four months later, on August 7th, 1943 (doc.6L).

2.2.4) Calogero Curatolo, born on May 16th, 1946 in Santo Padre delle Perriere (N.27/1946 S.P.P.).

On January 28th, 1986, Rosaria died in her own house in *c.da Fornara, 449*, in Petrosino (doc.5L).

2.3) Giuseppe Lombardo, born *via C. Isgrò* in Marsala on March 2nd, 1912, got married on December 26th, 1938 with Angela Galfano (doc.7L). I could document two children of theirs:

2.3.1) Caterina Lombardo, born on November 14th, 1940 in Petrosino (N.212/1940 Petr.).

2.3.2) Giuseppe Lombardo, a posthumous child, born in Petrosino on March 22nd, 1943, three months after his father's death (N.70/1943 Petr.).

As mentioned, Giuseppe Lombardo was an infantry soldier of the ARMIR, the Italian Contingent flanking the German Army in the invasion of the USSR. As many of his comrade in arms he got missed in action (MIA). In 1972, a special commission of the Italian Parliament examined the files of the Italian MIAs in Russia and Giuseppe Lombardo was declared officially MIA after December 15th, 1942 (doc.8L).

2.4) Rosa Lombardo, born in Petrosino on April 1st, 1916, got married on July 30th, 1955 with Antonino Pampalone (doc.9L). I could document only one child of this couple:

2.4.1) Giuseppa Pampalone, born on July 2nd, 1957 (N.35/1957 uff.2).

Rosa died in Petrosino on February 22nd, 2002 (doc.9L).

2.5) Vincenzo Lombardo, stillborn in Petrosino on July 6th, 1919 (doc.10L).

2.6) Vita Lombardo, born in Petrosino on February 8th, 1924, died three years later, on March 18th, 1927 (docs.11-12L).

Francesco died in *c.da Biscione* in Petrosino on July 22nd, 1957 (doc.1L).

3) Giovanni (I) was the only child of Giuseppe Lombardo and Rosaria Patti who died as a child. He was born on May 31st, 1870 in a courtyard of nowadays *via C. Isgrò* and there he died nineteen days later.

4) Vita, named after the paternal grandmother, was born on October 17th, 1873 in the same house where Giovanni was born three years earlier. When she was 20 years old, on November 25th, 1893, she got married with Vincenzo Indelicato, a peasant from Marsala too. I could document only one child for this couple, a stillborn:

4.1) Nicolò Indelicato, born on September 27th, 1895.

Vita died on September 23rd, 1896, one year after the unfortunate birth of Nicolò (doc.13L).

5) Anna, named after the maternal grandmother, was born in *via C. Isgrò* too on October 9th, 1875. She got married twice. The first time on January 9th, 1908, with Vincenzo Taranto, born in Mazara del Vallo, but residing in Marsala. I could document [two children](#) for this couple:

5.1) Antonina Taranto was born on March 25th, 1909 [in via C. Isgrò in Marsala](#). When she was almost 20 years old, on February 7th, 1929, she got married with Gaspare Indice. [I could document three children of theirs](#):

5.1.1) Pietro Indice, born on January 11th, 1930 (N.10/1930 uff.2).

5.1.2) Vincenzo (I) Indice, stillborn on February 4th, 1934 in Petrosino.

5.1.3) Vincenzo (II) Indice, born on November 4th, 1935 in Marsala and dead there five months later, on April 16th, 1936 (doc.16L).

One month after the birth of his third child, on December 4th, 1935, Antonina died in the hospital of *San Biagio* in Marsala (doc.15L).

5.2) Giuseppe Taranto was born on May 24th, 1911 in *via C. Isgrò* in Marsala. On April 21st, 1937, he got married with Francesca Chirco (doc.17L). They had three children:

5.2.1) Anna Taranto, born on February 8th, 1938 in Petrosino (N.19/1938 Petr.).

5.2.2) Vita Taranto, born on October 5th, 1939 in Petrosino (N.177/1939 Petr.).

5.2.3) Antonina Taranto, born on January 19th, 1943 (N.17/1939 Petr.).

Giuseppe's death his not noted in his birth record meaning it is possible he died elsewhere, and his death was never communicated to the hall of records in Marsala.

5.3) Leonardo Taranto, born in 1913 ca. I could not find his birth record, but he is the registrant of the death declaration of his mother in 1947 (doc.14L) and one of the witnesses to the declaration of death of his uncle Francesco Lombardo in 1957 (doc.1M).

On October 16th, 1939, when she was 64 years old, Anna Lombardo got married again in Petrosino. Her second husband's name was Ignazio Renda. [Anna died eight years later in Petrosino, on April 29th, 1947 \(doc.14L\)](#).

6) Giovanni (II), the client's ancestor, was born in *via Sanclimenti* on September 21st, 1877.

7) Giuseppe, the youngest child of Giuseppe Lombardo and Rosaria Maria Patti, was born on March 28th, 1880 in *via Sanclimenti* as well. He emigrated to the USA quite early, but than he got back to

Marsala, where, on February 13th, 1915, he got married with Ignazia Patti. I could document three children of this couple:

7.1) Giuseppe Lombardo, born on May 3rd, 1917 in *c.da Terrenuove, 6613*, got married in Marsala on January 24th, 1948 with Giovanna Regina (doc.19L). They had two children:

7.1.1) Ignazia Lombardo was born in Marsala on October 3rd, 1949. On April 30th, 1970, she got married with Guglielmo Casano (doc.21L). I could find her. She and her family agreed to meet the client should he come to Marsala and allowed me to share her contacts with him:

7.1.2) Francesco Giuseppe Lombardo, born in Marsala on January 19th, 1952 (N.93/1952).

Giuseppe Lombardo died on January 18th, 2000 in his house in *c.da Pastorella, 62* (doc.20L).

7.2) Rosaria Lombardo, born on December 23rd, 1919 in *c.da Terrenuove, 6615*, got married in Marsala on November 19th, 1938 with Vito Barraco (doc.22L). They had three children:

7.2.1) Giuseppe (I) Barraco was born in Santo Padre delle Perriere on December 28th, 1939. He died before 1944.

7.2.2) Ignazia Barraco, born in Santo Padre delle Perriere on January 11th, 1942 (N.6/1942 S.P.P). Her cousin Ignazia Lombardo told me she resides in Turin.

7.2.3) Giuseppe (II) Barracp, stillborn on October 8th, 1944 in Santo Padre delle Perriere.

Rosaria Lombardo died few days before her 28th birthday on December 12th, 1947 in her house in *c.da Terrenove, 189* (doc.23L).

7.3) Maria Lombardo was born on February 14th, 1929 in *c.da Terrenove* (doc.24L). Her birth record does not show neither birth nor wedding annotation. It may also mean she is still alive and unmarried. Her niece Ignazia Lombardo can give information on this.

Giuseppe Lombardo died in *c.da Scacciamennole* in Marsala on June 7th, 1947 (doc.18L).

Giuseppe Lombardo died 60 years old on August 4th, 1901, in *via Lazzerara*, when his mother, Vita De Vita, was still alive. His wife, Rosaria Patti survived him twenty-three years and died 77 years old

on December 18th, 1924, in *c.da Pastorella*, in the countryside south of Marsala, not far from Petrosino and Strasatti.

Angela Marino's family

Angela Marino's father, Andrea Marino, was born on September 7th, 1826 in Marsala, in *via dell'Infermaria*, to Andrea (b.1791 ca.) and Rosa Marino (b.1802 ca.), both peasants (doc.49). Andrea got married twice. His first wife was Francesca Morana, a foundling born in 1833 ca. I could document four children of the couple, all dead as a child, except one:

- 1) Andrea (I) was born on July 15th, 1861 in *via C. Isgrò* and died one week later in *via Cavazza*. He was baptised in the parish of *San Matteo*.
 - 2) Andrea (II) was born in *via Cavazza* on March 23rd, 1863 and died there one year and nine months later, on December 14th, 1864. He was baptised in the parish of *San Matteo* too.
 - 3) Andrea (III), the only child of Francesca Morano who survived to adulthood, was born on October 19th, 1869 in *via Curatulo* and, alike his homonym father, got married twice. The first time, he got married with Angela Pipitone on February 11th, 189. I could document [three](#) children of this couple, [all](#) born in *contrada Bambina*. [The long gaps between the births of the three siblings may suggest that this family did not resided in Marsala for long intervals of time.](#)
 - 3.1) Francesca Marino, born on May 15th, 1898.
 - 3.2) Andrea Marino was born on January 3rd, 1910 [and died in Turin on October 16th, 1941 \(doc.2M\).](#)
 - 3.2) Antonio Marino was born on April 5th, 1919 and died in Gorizia on December 30th, 1946 [\(doc.3M\).](#)
- On September 1st, 1918, when he was almost 49 years old, Andrea Marino got married again, this time with Girolama Scalia. Andrea Marino died on October 7th, 1960 [in c.da Sant'Anna](#), in the northern part of the territory of Marsala: he was 91 years old [\(doc.1M\).](#)
- 4) Antonio (I) was born on May 17th, 1873 in *via Grazia Vecchia* and died there eighteen days later, on June 4th.

Francesca Morana died in *via Grazia Vecchia* on May 29th, 1873, most likely due to the consequences of the childbirth he had gone through twelve days earlier. She was 40 years old. Four months later, on October 4th, 1873, Andrea Marino got married with Rosa Mezzapelle, the mother of Angela Marino. Rosa was twenty-three years younger than her husband: she was born on March 1st, 1850 in

via Santa Caterina to Francesco (b.1820 ca.) and Maria Venera Pellegrino (b.1828 ca.), both peasants. Andrea Marino and his second wife had six children:

5) Angela (I) was born on August 7th, 1874 in *via Macina*, ten months after her parents' wedding. She died on January 16th, 1879 when she was 4 years old and her family had already moved to *via Dagotti*.

6) Maria Venera, named after her maternal grandmother, was born on October 21st, 1876 in *via Dagotti* (doc.34). She got married with Melchiorre Figlioli on January 13th, 1896 and the couple had [five](#) children I could document:

6.1) Andrea Figlioli was born [in c.da Rina](#) on June 2nd, 1899 and on January 6th, 1926 got married with Caterina De Vita. He kept residing in Marsala as we find him reporting his maternal grandmother's death in 1928. Moreover, he should be the one writing to Irene Pulizzi in 1956 and who met "Peter" during his visit to Marsala. Andrea refers to Peter as a nephew, but indeed he was the son of a first cousin of his. Andrea Figlioli is the only member of the family who is reported not to be a peasant or a farmer as he was a duty officer. In 1945, he recognized a child and he formally adopted him in 1953 ([doc.5M](#)):

6.1.1) Salvatore Figlioli (born Fighetti), born in Marsala on March 6th, 1942 (N.41 pt.II B/1953).

The latter reported the death of his adoptive father, occurred on March 10th, 1978 in a house in *via San Giovanni Bosco, 36* in Marsala ([doc.6M](#)).

6.2) Pasquale Figlioli was born on December 12th, 1903 and on February 6th, 1932, he got married with [Anna Montalto](#) ([doc.7M](#)). I could document two children of this couple:

6.2.1) Melchiorre (I) Figlioli, born in Petrosino on February 25th, 1934 and dead in *c.da Gazzarella* eight days later, on March 2nd ([doc.9M](#)).

6.2.2) Melchiorre (II) Figlioli, born in Petrosino on August 10th, 1938 (N.103/1938 Petr.).

Pasquale died in *c.da Torreviggiano, 48*, on January 29th, 1975 ([doc.8M](#)).

6.3) Antonio Figlioli was born on December 17th, 1906 in *c.da Dammusello* and got married with Maria Amato on April 9th, 1932 ([doc.10M](#)). I could document two children of theirs:

6.3.1) Melchiorre Figlioli, born on April 4th, 1943 (N.19/1943 S.P.P.).

6.3.2) Diana Venera Figlioli, born on March 27th, 1946 (N.345/1946).

Antonio died in *c.da Pastorella*, 147, on July 7th, 1995; his death was declared by a man whose name was Antonio Figlioli, born in Marsala on December 25th, 1975, most likely the son of a son of his (doc.11M).

6.4) Vitina Figlioli was born in *c.da Dammusello* on February 27th, 1910 and got married with Antonino Genovese on April 1st, 1930 (doc.12M). I could document five children of this couple:

6.4.1) Maria Genovese, born on New Year's Day 1934 (N.13/1934).

6.4.2) Andrea Genovese, born on November 18th, 1936 (N.945/1936).

6.4.3) Melchiorre Genovese, born on November 28th, 1940 (N.1300/1940). I met him in his house in *c.da Ventreschi*, 330. He is an old man, living with his wife in a humble house close to the house where a child of his lives with his family. Melchiorre is toothless and quite hear-impaired, but kind. He told me that his eldest siblings have died already, but his younger siblings are still alive and reside in *c.da Berbarello*. He told me he would not be interested in meeting any American relative and this was confirmed by his child.

6.4.4) Vito Genovese, born on March 1st, 1944 (N.206/1944).

6.4.5) Antonia Genovese, born on April 29th, 1947 (N.675/1947).

Vitina died in *c.da Terrenove*, 177, on December 28th, 1982 (doc.13M).

6.5) Rosa Figlioli was born in *c.da Terrenove*, 4673, on March 17th, 1914 and got married with Gioacchino Catalano on July 15th, 1936 (doc.14M). I could document seven children of theirs:

6.5.1) Carmela Catalano, born on September 11th, 1937 (N.850/1937).

6.5.2) Maria Catalano, born on April 4th, 1940 (N.424/1940).

6.5.3) Francesca Catalano, born on December 19th, 1942 and dead five months later in *c.da Terrenove*, on May 25th, 1943 (doc.16M).

6.5.4) Vincenzo Catalano, born on April 26th, 1944 (N.362/1944).

6.5.5) Vita Catalano, born in *c.da Terrenove*, 30 on October 1st, 1950, got married with Tommaso Caradonna on June 14th, 1979 (doc.17M).

6.5.6) Melchiorre Catalano, born on March 29th, 1954 (N.38/1954 uff.7). I met him in the yard in *c.da Ciavoli* where he manages a tractors repair and renting shop with his elder brother Vincenzo. He showed himself very available and curious of meeting the client. He asked me to keep him informed,

should the client decide to go and visit Marsala. Also, he agreed to share his phone number with the client.

On March 29th, 1998, Rosa died in *c.da Terrenove, 176*, in the house by the one her sister Vitina had resided before her death in 1982 (doc.15M).

Maria Venera died on April 17th, 1935 in the family house in *c.da Terrenove, 4673* (doc.4M).

7) Antonio (II) was born on January 23rd, 1880 in *c.da Terrenove* and got married with Maria Agate on January 29th, 1912, as reported by the client with a little spelling difference concerning his wife's surname. Shortly after, he emigrated to the United States where he and his wife had offspring. He died on July 27th, 1960.

8) Angela (II), the client's ancestor, was born in *via Dagotti* on August 11th, 1882.

9) Michela (I) was born on December 2nd, 1885 in *c.da Bambina* and died seven months later in *via Dagotti*.

10) Michela (II) was born on November 9th, 1893 in *c.da Terrenove* when her parents were 67 and 43 years old already. She got to America in 1917 and there she got married with Antonino Lombardo and had several children. She died on May 20th, 1980.

Andrea Marino died 80 years old on March 29th, 1907 in his house in *c.da Bambina*. It was the same place where twenty-one years later, on December 28th, 1928, his widow Rosa Mezzapelle died 78 years old.

Further perspectives

It was not possible to track the ancestry of Bernardo Pulizzi and Rosaria Lombardo further back in the past for the same health restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemics operating at the end of 2020. I got in touch with the recordkeepers, and they told me to give a new try in March. I contacted the genealogical association in Marsala which should have access to the digitized copies of the books of the *Chiesa Madre*. The quote they gave me for their documental research is about 600 euros which would involve the simple collection of the documents without any further elaboration of the information acquired.

Concerning the issue of documenting Rosaria Lombardo's birth for dual citizenship purposes, I could not look for Rosaria Lombardo's baptism record for the same reasons of inaccessibility to the church records. The baptism record would provide an alternative to her birth record in documenting

her birth. This problem relies on the fact that apparently Rosaria's birth was not reported to the *Stato Civile* of Marsala at the time of her birth in 1904.

Concerning the goal of looking for living relatives of the client on the Lombardo and Marino side of the family, I could get in touch with three families, one on the Lombardo side and two on the Marino side. A new session could be arranged to get in touch with more relatives. Alternatively, this is a quest that could be performed during the visit of the client, should he plan to spend a couple days in Marsala.

Death record N.18 – 1957 – *Comune* of Marsala / Section of Petrosino

City delegation – July 20th, 1957, at 10.20 AM

Registrar: Carmelo Benigno, by Mayor's application duly approved on September 30th, 1952.

Registrant: Antonino Pampalone, son of the late Cosimo, 42 years old, shepherd, residing in Marsala.

Witnesses: Vincenzo Paladino, son of the late Sebastiano, 40 years old, and Leonardo Taranto, son of the late Vincenzo, 44 years old, both farmers residing in Marsala.

Declaration: on July 22nd, 1957, at 3 AM, Francesco Lombardo died in a house in *contrada Biscione*. He was 91 years old, farmer, born and residing in Marsala. His parents were the late Giuseppe, farmer, and Rosaria Patti, housewife, both formerly residing in Marsala. He was the husband of Caterina Ampola.

Signed by the registrar, the registrants, and the witnesses.

City delegation – October 5th, 1907, at 7.30 AM

Registrar: Francesco Giacalone Vita, by application, duly approved on December 26th, 1903.

Registrant: Francesco Lombardo, 40 years old, peasant, residing in Marsala.

Declaration: on October 2nd, 1907, at 11 AM, Caterina Ampola, legitimate wife and cohabitant of the registrant, gave birth to a girl in a house located in *villa San Giuseppe*. The girl was given the name Rosaria.

Witnesses: Vincenzo Taranto, 37 years old, peasant, and Rosaria Patti, 51 years old, farmer, both residing in this *Comune*.

Signed only by the registrar, the registrant and the witnesses being illiterate.

3L. Lombardo Rosaria

Death record N.53 – 1907 – *Comune* of Marsala / Section of Petrosino

City delegation – November 19th, 1907, at 8 AM

Registrar: Francesco Giacalone Vita, by application duly approved on December 26th, 1903.

Registrants: Francesco Lombardo, 40 years old, peasant, and Baldassarre Pugliese, 58 years old, butcher, both residing in Marsala.

Declaration: on November 18th, 1907, at noon, Rosaria Lombardo died in a house in Petrosino. She was 1 month and 16 days old, born and residing in Marsala. Her parents were Francesco, peasant, and Caterina Ampola, farmer, both residing in Marsala.

Witnesses: Mario Di Paolo, 63 years old, shoemaker, and Giuseppe Di Nicola, 56 years old, farmer, both residing in this *Comune*.

Signed only by the registrar, the registrant and the witnesses being illiterate.

4L. Lombardo Rosaria

Birth record N.373 – 1909 – *Comune* of Marsala

City hall – March 21st, 1909, at 11.15 AM

Registrar: Paolo Pugliese, city chief clerk in third section, by application, duly approved on July 31st, 1892.

Having examined the documents provided by the Ministry of the Defence about Giuseppe Lombardo, son of Francesco and Caterina Ampola, 30 years old, husband of Angela Galfano, born on March 2nd, 1912, in Marsala, Trapani (birth record N.339 pt.I), Military District of Palermo and former suppressed Military District of Trapani, Serial Number 22357, residing in Marsala (Trapani), belonging to the 82nd regiment Infantry, the following assumption could be stated:

- On December 15th, 1942, the soldier Giuseppe Lombardo was in Russia with the 82nd regiment Infantry.*
- On December 15th, 1942, the soldier Giuseppe Lombardo, got missing following the war facts on the Russian front.*
- Following those war facts, the soldier Giuseppe Lombardo was not reckoned among those whose death was legally ascertained and all further attempted investigation and research – no matter the know-how and the methodology used – have proved vain to that extent.*

Considering that Giuseppe Lombardo is still missing after the abovementioned war facts, that no news has been reported about him for more than two years, and that all the circumstances make presumable he died there and then, according to D.L.L. April 5th, 1946 N.216 modified with Law February 17th, 1970 N.90 states that Giuseppe Lombardo got missing and declares that he presumably died on December 15th, 1942 in the abovementioned circumstances.
