## **ADRC: Aging & DisabilityResource Center**

Carla Berscheit, Dementia Care Specialist from the Aging & Disability Resource Center (ADRC), gave a presentation to our club at the September 25 meeting.

Prior to joining the ADRC in 2020, Carla worked as an Occupational Therapist for over 20 years. Often, the people she worked with had varying stages of dementia too, which required additional evaluation and coordination to ensure a safe return to their prior living environment. She has a passion for reaching caregivers and empowering them with education and resources to do their personal best.

#### **Dementia Statistics:**

\*5.8 million Americans with some form of dementia

\*126,00 people in Wisconsin have diagnosed dementia

\*Estimated to reach 216,000 people in Wisconsin with dementia by 2035.

\*There are 70-100 different types of dementia \*Alzheimer's Disease is the most common type.
