- At the end of 2019 we saw a number of children head off to big school and we wish them the very best for their formal schooling years.
- Throughout the year we have maintained steady enrolments and have had very few vacancies at any one time.
- The staff at Muswellbrook Pre School continue to inspire me each and every day and are a credit to themselves, Muswellbrook Pre School and the Early Childhood industry. Thank you for your dedication to Preschool.
- We have enjoyed many travelling shows this year with a few favorites being the Sea Life Show and Healthy Harold.
- Stage 2 and 3 were completed in our Hill Street yard makeover and we celebrated this with a grand opening in September in conjunction with our annual Book Week Parade.
- In July we helped coordinate and run the Muswellbrook Shires 'Community Transition to School' evening. Many thanks to Bengalla for sponsoring the evening, we had over 50 families attended, all local schools, local intervention agencies and stalls of interest for families to visit.
