Updates were given on the City\School library renewal agreement and the Ag Greenhouse project. Dakota Sign should have quotes on signage soon. Bus #4 has been damaged beyond repair. Additional cameras have been installed. Deledao software program is being purchased to help monitor inappropriate online searches. Back to School Night is August 15, 2023, from 6-8 pm. Mr. Schmidt will be attending the Superintendent conference July 17-19, 2023.

<u>2023-2024</u> Projected Enrollment is 146 for the district. Clark Colony is 19, Hillside Colony Elementary is 11. Hillside High School is 2, Camrose Colony is 13, and Doland Attendance center is 104 for a total of 146. This does not include preschool count of 13 students.

Budget Hearing for the 2023-2024: Mrs. Wipf presented the 2023-2024 District Budget. It was noted that changes may be made in the next two months to the budget, with final approval at the September 2023 regular board meeting.
