School Meals Information

The Doland Elementary, Doland Junior High, and Doland High School's application for free school breakfast and lunch has been approved the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the State of South Dakota. The school will provide free breakfast and lunch for all students enrolled in the school district. This program does not require any action from families in order for your student(s) to receive free meals.

This program will run from October 1, 2020, to May 21, 2021, or until the federal funding runs out. The school district will credit your child's account from October 1 through October 15. The school encourages families to please pay off negative lunch accounts.

If your student(s) wishes to purchase extra entrees, milk, or other food items, it will be charged to their account. Please remember a second meal cost \$1.30, and a milk with a sack lunch will be charged \$.50.
