We expect to replace several tires.

<u>Business Manager's Report:</u> Mrs. Wipf shared that an Opt-Out referendum petition was filed, DLA has authorized Cahill Bauer & Associates for FY25 audit, ASBSD Policy Alerts on Election Law changes, background checks, and Open meeting law changes.

**Budget Hearing for the 2025-2026:** Mrs. Wipf presented the 2025-2026 District Budget. It was noted that changes may be made in the next two months to the budget, with final approval at the September 2025 regular board meeting. The Board of Education acknowledged the review of the budget. No action was taken.
