**Pray for the Nations:** The United States, Iran, Israel, Middle East, Ukraine, Cuba, Democratic Republic of Congo (ebola outbreak)



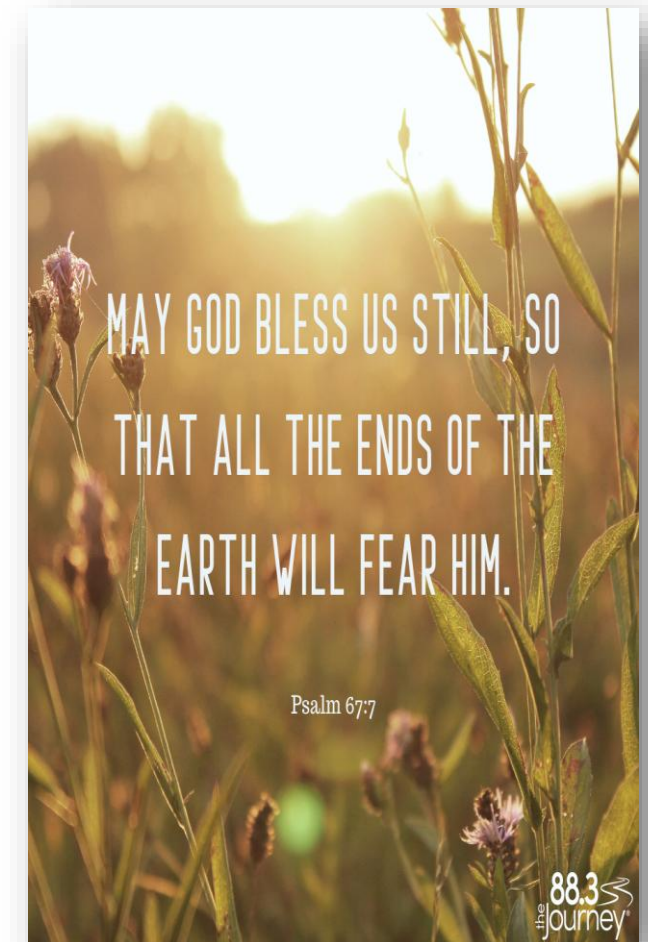
