Highlights from the Fiscal Year

#GivingTuesday w/ Portage Health Foundation (Dec 2019)

Although #GivingTuesday 2020 was just a few weeks ago, it's last year's #GT that is part of this fiscal year. With many generous donations from the community and matching funds from PHF, \$29,555 was raised for Dial Help!

Volunteer Wins Award (March 2020)

Melissa Santini has been a volunteer at Dial Help since 2015. This year, she was awarded Grow & Lead's UP Service Award for her dedication to the community. Melissa has answered over 800 crisis calls, and drives from Ontonagon to Houghton every week, rain, snow, or shine!



Peer Recovery Coach Training Complete (March 2020)

Syringe Services Program (April 2020)

With the Western UP Health Department, we began hosting a harm reduction program to reduce the health risks associated with IV drug use and link participants to treatment services for recovery.



Portage Lake District Library Summer Reading Program

PLDL's Summer Reading Program was sponsored by Portage Health Foundation. The program logged over 7,600 reading hours, raising \$1,604 through PHF for Dial Help. Thank you readers, PLDL, and PHF!

Communities That Care (CTC) Coalitions (Summer/Fall 2020)

Our agency coordinates the Baraga County and Houghton/Keweenaw Communities That Care (CTC) coalitions. The #HKCTC held a revitalization meeting in July, and both coalitions participated in DHHS's Narcan Distribution Day on August 31. Both coalitions also held Suicide Prevention Month events.









Billboards in Chassel & Lake Linden

Upper Great Lakes Family Health Centers put new billboards up to promote resources for those dealing with opioid misuse, including Dial Help. The billboards were funded by a HRSA R-CORP grant.

Facing Addiction through Community Engagement (Sep 2020)

The Western UP Health Department was awarded a HRSA grant to address the needs for loved ones of those dealing with addiction, with Dial Help, KBIC, and Lac Vieux as partners.



Child Advocacy Center Opens (Sep 2020)

Now providing support and services children under 18 who are severely or sexually abused. Funded by the Michigan DHHS.




