Contact Dial Help directly at **906-482-HELP**. Dial Help staff will ask the following questions :

1. Does the person in crisis need immediate medical attention? *
2. Is the person in crisis intoxicated? *
3. Is the person in crisis violent? *
4. Is there anyone else involved in the crisis?



Mobile Response Team

Face-to-face crisis intervention at schools and agencies in Baraga, Houghton, Ontonagon, and Keweenaw Counties

Special services available for youth age 18 and under



About Mobile Response

Dial Help's Mobile Response Team (MRT) responds to requests from schools and agencies in the four-county area between 9am - 9pm, usually within 45 minutes

The goals of MRT are to:

- Assist in times of mental and emotional distress
- Promote safety, support, and positive coping skills
- Connect to local service providers

What is a Crisis?

An emotionally significant event or radical change of status in a person's life

A crisis for one person might not be a crisis for another

The biggest sign of a crisis is that the situation is causing someone genuine distress that they are struggling with

When to Contact MRT

If a student, client, or other individual in a school or agency is experiencing a problem and needs assistance coping

If you're not sure whether to contact MRT, please contact Dial Help for more info

NOTE: call 911 if the person in crisis needs medical attention or is being violent

Special Youth Services

Specialty services are available to support individuals under 18:

Clinical counseling provided by a licensed social worker if unable to access services elsewhere

Family support services to help address multi-generational issues impacting the youth

Juvenile justice response to help youth stay on track with their probation requirements, and prevent future delinquent or criminal behavior
