Special Youth Services Launched

This year, Portage Health Foundation awarded Dial Help funds to create a Youth One-Stop. The program was launched this summer, serving the four county area.



“The goal of the Youth One-Stop is to ensure that all youth in need of mental health services receive them,” said Rebecca Crane, Executive Director. “We decided the buck stops here—if a youth is linked with our agency, we will get them help.”

“Our #RiseTogether challenge which was held last October cemented the Portage Health Foundation’s commitment to meet the increasing mental and behavioral health needs of our youth,” said Kevin Store, Portage Health Foundation Executive Director. “The funding support we have provided Dial Help to expand its youth services programming is directly related to that promise; that we would not be a community that turned away from what your children are experiencing and most importantly what they had to say that day.”

PHF’s funding allowed Dial Help to hire a full-time social worker who will meet with youth in school, provide case management, and offer counseling to those who cannot access it through any other means. The program also offers family support services without Child Protective Services eligibility required.

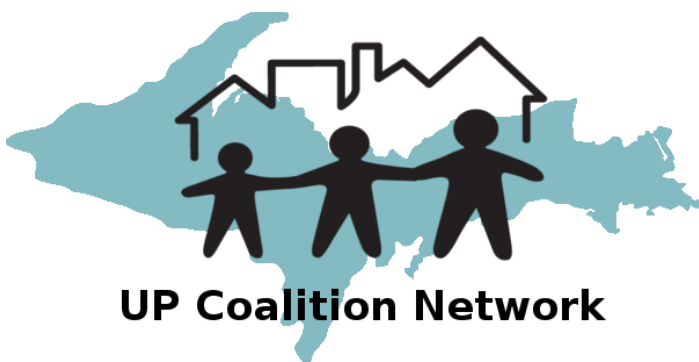

New Collaborations

A big source of excitement this quarter is new partnerships, and strengthening collaborations with existing partners.

Dial Help and MDHHS will be developing a Child Advocacy Center (CAC) to provide services to youth who have experienced sexual or physical abuse. This will create accessible, trauma-informed services locally and eliminate the need to travel downstate.

Dial Help is working with the FDA and MDHHS on a statewide initiative to prevent tobacco from being sold to minors.

Dial Help, MI Rural EMS Network, Great Lakes Recovery Centers, and NorthCare Network were awarded an HRSA grant to develop a regional UP strategic plan to address the opioid crisis, among other initiatives.

Dial Help and NorthCare were awarded a grant from Superior Health Foundation to address Substance Use Disorder UP-wide. This is the second year of funding for this collaborative project, which includes options for both prevention and intervention for SUD.
