## **Agency Updates**

#### BARAGA CTC

Dial Help is now the lead agency coordinating the Baraga County Communities That Care (CTC) coalition. We're excited to be able to support youth -focused prevention in this county!

We also provide Guiding Good Choices parenting classes, Botvin's Lifeskills student classes, and TOP Club in Baraga.

#### **MOBILE RESPONSE TEAM**

The Mobile Response Team (MRT) offers face-to-face crisis intervention in Baraga, Houghton, Keweenaw, and Ontonagon Counties with funding from Portage Health Foundation and Gogebic-Ontonagon ISD.

With additional funding from Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan and the BCBS MI Foundation, we expanded our MRT hours last year. **MRT services are now available from 9am to 9pm, seven days a week.** 

The MRT has a special focus on serving youth, but also works with adults as needed. To learn more or request an MRT response, contact Dial Help at 482-HELP or by texting 35NEEDS.

#### VICTIM SERVICES

Our Victim Services Unit (VSU) offers direct support to victims of sexual assault and other crimes in the Copper Country. Advocates also work in the community help prevent crimes like domestic violence, sexual assault, and more.

This quarter, our VSU team participated in a number of community trainings with partners including Little Brothers Friends of the Elderly, Finlandia University, and Michigan Tech.

We have a new crafting support group for sexual assault survivors. No matter how long ago the abuse happened, heal with others in this safe space. See page 6 for info.

VSU is funded by the MI DHHS Division of Victim of Services.

#### **SUICIDE PREVENTION**

September was National Suicide Prevention month, and Dial Help promoted this important topic throughout the month. This included sharing info on social media and helping out with community presentations.

Dial Help supported Baraga County CTC's Warr;or Walk and Houghton/Keweenaw CTC's Live for Tomorrow Walk, as well as UP Coalition Network's first ever UP Wide Preventing Suicide Walk/Run/Bike event. Dial Help staff were at these events and assisted with outreach to promote them.

In partnership with the Marquette County Health Department and UP Coalition Network, Dial Help oversaw planning for the Fourth Annual UP Suicide Prevention Conference in Marquette. This was funded by Communities United for Suicide Prevention.
