I understand and agree to the following principles and practices during my time volunteering at Dial Help:

- 1. Review my volunteer <u>Orientation Binder</u>
- 2. Adhere to Dial Help's Confidentiality Policy
- Adhere to Dial Help's dress code of business casual while volunteering for Dial Help, unless otherwise indicated by the Volunteer Coordinator
- 4. Pass background checks, depending my volunteer level
- 5. Work with the Volunteer Coordinator or other Dial Help staff to plan my weekly volunteering schedule
- 6. Check in with the Volunteer Coordinator weekly by phone call, text message, email, or in-person
- Let the Volunteer Coordinator know of changes in my schedule that will affect my volunteering
- 8. Let the Volunteer Coordinator know if I plan to end my volunteer commitment
- 9. Email the Volunteer Coordinator a log of volunteer hours bi-weekly
- 10. Independently manage my time while volunteering to complete the tasks I have agreed to perform
- 11. Refrain from discriminating against clients, staff, or other volunteers on the basis of race, ethnicity, sex, age, sexual orientation, gender identity, religion, disability status, marriage status, or any other condition

I understand that if I fail to follow to the standards above, I may not receive a professional reference from Dial Help.
