Intent

We, as on-ice officials, must command the respect of all participants in the game. When we enter the arena most parents and coaches see us and recognize us as the officials. When we walk in dressed professionally, we begin to earn their respect.

Conversely, if we enter the arena in tattered clothing or present ourselves in an otherwise unprofessional manner, we lose their respect quickly.

The intent of this policy is to provide guidance to officials as to what clothing is deemed to be acceptable attire without being overly restrictive. Following this dress code will serve to demonstrate your respect for the game, the players, the coaches and your fellow officials. It will also help you to earn their respect from the moment you arrive at the arena.
