TBA PROCESS

This document describes the TBA process in Horizon. This is a 4-part process.

- 1. You would put the game up for trade using the TBA system.
- 2. Officials would apply to take the game off your hands.
- 3. You would assign the game to an official from all of those that applied to officiate the game.
- 4. The official that you assign the game to would have to confirm their acceptance of the game.

A test game was created for demonstration purposes.

If you want to put a game up for TBA, you click the little upward pointing finger to initiate the process and click "Proceed".



In attempt to cut down on the number of emails that people are getting for TBA's, in the "Who should receive this TBA" select "A Contact Group". Then select the group that belongs to the level, for this demonstration it is Atom A – Test. For our games, there will be no contract group for '- cash' games. If you are attempting to trade a cash game, i.e. "Atom A – Cash", just select "Atom A". All House League Games say "HL/House" in the descriptions, so if you are trading a Peewee House game, select "Peewee HL/House Referee". Please do not change the "Email Notification Max Distance". As you can see, for the three-official games, there is a choice between Referee and Linesman. Please choose the appropriate position.



Officials in that contact group will now see an email like this:


A fellow official, Megan Lamont, has posted a game that needs to be taken and is available for you to request.

Please login and view the assignment to request them. To view, click TBA REQUESTS on the right hand grey navigation menu. If the link 'TBA REQUESTS' or the assignments do not display after adjusting the schedule filters, then another user may have already received the assignment and it may no longer be available. You can also access this by going to your Game Schedule and clicking the 'show available games' link at the top of the page. There is no guarantee that this game will be available for any certain length of time. Once Megan Lamont fills the assignments, it will no longer be displayed to you.

You may receive an email response right away stating that someone has responded to your TBA Request. It is just Horizon filling your name and email address. This does not mean that you have someone interested in taking the game, yet. This can be verified by looking at your personal schedule.



Once someone asks for the game that you have created the TBA for, the number under the action column changes from 0 to however many grab it (in this case 1).

To request a game from the TBA Board, you click on the white icon on the right:



When someone requests your game, you will receive an email notification like this one:



The person is applying to take the game from you. At the end of the process they will have to confirm that they are still willing to take the game.


Once you have received requests to take your game, you will see a number like below:



Click on the number. You will see your name and the names of the people requesting the game.



Click the white icon beside the official to whom you wish to give the game then click "Transfer Assignment".



Please note that the official still has to confirm the game before the transfer is complete. An email is sent to that official to confirm the assignment.



Once they confirm, the process is complete.
