The Lord has called us, as women intercessors, to fast and pray on Yom Kippur, The Day of Atonement, in Ottawa on **October 12**th, **2024**, to speak out against the spirit of the age, attacking families, women and children in our nation.

When Esther explained that anyone approaching the king without being summoned is put to death unless he extends his scepter, Mordecai sent back another message: "Do not think that because you are in the king's house you alone of all Jews will escape.

FOR IF YOU REMAIN SILENT AT THIS TIME, RELIEF AND DELIVERENCE FOR THE JEWS WILL ARISE FROM ANOTHER PLACE BUT YOU AND YOUR FATHER'S HOUSE WILL PERISH. AND WHO KNOWS THAT YOU HAVE COME TO THE ROYAL POSITION FOR SUCH A TIME AS THIS.

Haman had partnered with evil and was handing Israel over unto death. However, God Almighty was piercing and exposing all the corruption that had been covered up in secret.

It is written: "Woe to those who go to great depths to hide their plans from the Lord, who do their work in darkness and think "who sees us? Who will know?"

Haman oppressed the people of Israel brutally, in order to silence and annihilate them. This is currently what is happening in the church today. It is being silenced so it can no longer function in its original calling. As a result, this will redefine the nation.

God is raising up the Esthers, like mother bears, that are coming over the mountains to Ottawa this year – on Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement, on October 12, 2024, with a resolve in their eyes to protect their young, to restore the family, to redeem the unborn, and to retrieve the lost prodigals, young and old.

God is calling you, daughter, to a charge, to arise as a mother over Canada and to take back the land you have been assigned. We are defenders over our families.

It is a divine call from heaven resting upon us in this hour.

Do not hold back, and just as Esther had the courage to enter the palace of the king under the pain of death, you, too, will be stepping into your divine appointment, your divine calling in the power of the Holy Spirit.

Rise up daughters of the King, step up, and speak out in this moment daughter, for who knows, you were called "For such a time as this".
