

## Coppell Competitive Shooting Team Varsity Letter Program

In order to earn a Varsity letter on the Coppell Competitive Shooting Team (CCST) for 2020-2021 school year, athletes must earn a minimum of 50 points via the following point system as well as meet the minimum requirements stated below. Points will be earned through participation in the activities in the below matrix.

## The following are minimum requirements to earn a Varsity Letter regardless of points earned.

- Complete mandatory safety training.
- Be a high school team member on the Varsity squad or a senior on the JV squad
  - o (Middle school students cannot letter regardless of squad.)
- Follow the CCST Code of Conduct and Team Rules
- Follow the CISD School Code of Conduct
- Do not break a safety violation intentionally (Coach/Board discretion)

## **Point Matrix**

Points	Activity
1	Each Practice (minimum of 50 targets per practice)
1	Team service activities including fundraisers, range preparation (i.e. loading target houses), etc. (1 pt. per event)
3	Per event at team tournament (i.e. sporting clays, trap or skeet)
5	Registered Competition outside of team (Proof of competition must be submitted to Coach/Board)
5	Leadership Role (Coach/Board discretion)
15	Team State Championship*
15	National Championship*
	*The previous year's competition counts for the next academic school year's
	requirements due to the summer competition.

The athlete must complete the minimum requirements and then earn the remaining points as he/she desires via the point system above. If the minimum of 50 points is not reached, the athlete will not letter. Additional points may be awarded by the Coaches/Board at their sole discretion.

A Lettering Journal will be provided to all athletes who qualify for the varsity lettering program. The Lettering Journal will be the official record of points earned for all athletes. The journal will provide a section for each type of activity in which points can be earned.

The athletes are responsible for documenting their activities and having a coach or board member sign off on his/her activities. Once the needed points are obtained or at the end of the season, the athlete needs to submit the Lettering Journal to the Coaches/Board.

At the end of the season, the Board/Coaches will confirm that the athlete met the minimum requirements and will review all the Letter Notebook to ensure that the athlete obtained the minimum of 50 points. Athletes must also be in good standing with the CCST Team Rules at the completion of the season. If an athlete breaks any of the team rules and receives any documented verbal or written warnings, the athlete may lose the chance to letter for the current season.

## **Letter Jackets and Team Patches**

Varsity team members who letter may purchase a letter jacket. The purchase of a letter jacket includes the award letter on the front left breast of the jacket.

Team patches are received with initial purchase of jacket. (Jackets must be purchased individually at school) Additional optional patches and embellishments may be purchased. Some examples: name, year, etc.

Any questions or comments regarding an athlete's lettering for the season should first be directed to the Board/Coaches.
