





A Message From... **Chairperson, IAMACF**

Dear Friends and Distinguished Guests,

I have great pleasure in welcoming all of you to the IAMA Business Meeting and IAMACF Annual Fundraising Gala. The funds generated from this gala help us in running the free charitable clinic. The Indian American Medical Association Charitable Foundation Free Health Clinic is a non-profit organization that was established in 1994. While located in the West Ridge community, we care for patients from many parts of Illinois, including the city and suburbs of Chicago. The free clinic serves low-income populations, who are uninsured and underserved that have no or limited access to affordable medical facilities for their healthcare needs. Patient services are provided without regard to nationality, ethnicity, religion, gender, or race.

While ACA has increased healthcare access, gaps still remain due to affordability, transition between jobs, immigration status, and enrollment period cut-offs, in addition to the shortage of Medicaid providers outside major metropolitan areas. Illinois has the 8th highest uninsured population in the country. In 2017, approximately 1.12M Illinois residents were uninsured. About 290,000 of uninsured Illinois residents are undocumented immigrants, ineligible for health coverage; 92% of this population live in the Chicago area. Free and charitable clinics are communities' response to the healthcare needs of their population. Every \$1 donated to a clinic provides a minimum of \$5 worth of healthcare services.

In 2018, 2100 patient encounters were seen at the clinic. Numerous events were hosted such as Healthy Lifestyle Intervention, Women's Health Initiative, Mental Health Clinic, and Continued Optometry Clinics, Dermatology Clinics, and Illinois Society of Preventing Blindness (ISPB) held a clinic in August. "Time is the essence in primary care" and these educational sessions offer the patients an additional opportunity to learn about their disease and ask any questions they might have. Despite our best efforts, there is almost always increased need in the community for services. For advocacy of what we do, the clinic is participating in a visit to Springfield to meet the Legislators on March 20th, 2019.

IAMACF is proud to have affiliations with Cardinal Health, Illinois College of Optometry, Indian American Medical Association, John H. Stroger Jr. Ambulatory Care, Medstar Laboratories, New Life Volunteer Society, Presence St. Francis Hospital, and Rosalind Franklin University Chicago Medical School. I would like to thank American Academy of Family Physicians and Illinois Association of Free & Charitable Clinics for their generous grants to support our work. IAMACF is also aligned with eco-friendly and Go Green initiatives by usage of electronic records for documentation.

I love working with my Board, who are always enthusiastic and eager to share knowledge and ideas and extremely helpful. I sincerely appreciate all the clinic volunteers who take time out of their busy schedules and family time to care for the patients. I urge to promote volunteerism in physicians. If a Physician could volunteer two Sundays a year, that would enhance our patient services. Please open your heart and help the clinic in expanding services to needy patients.

I had the privilege of knowing Dr. Usha Nimmagadda for a little over 2 years and cherish her memory. I wish, I had known her for longer period of time. No words can describe the amount of community service that she provided. Her mission, "Manav seva is Madhav seva", which translates to "Service to Humanity is Service to God", will continue.

As for the future of IAMACF, I believe that we will do our best to continue to expand and improve the breadth and depth of the services that we provide.

Message from The Executive Director

Welcome to the 2019 Indian American Medical Association Charitable Foundation (IAMACF) Gala. It gives me great pleasure that you are celebrating the Free Health Clinic's 25th Anniversary of operation. This fundraiser gives us the opportunity to thank everyone and allows us to look to the future.

For 25 years the free health clinic has provided free primary medical care to patients in need, regardless of race, gender, creed, or socioeconomic status. Over the past 25 years, the clinic has evolved tremendously, but the core foundation of the clinic has remained true to its inception. Since 1994, IAMACF has been dedicated to providing standard of care medical practices to a community replete with immigrants and refugees that are unable to afford healthcare. Because of the 450 hours of physician volunteering and 370 different medical students volunteering, the clinic was able to hold its mission statement in 2018, to serve the underserved.

This past July with the partnership of Rosalind Franklin Medical School, the free clinic was able to have a third operational day and re-open the Wednesday clinic. Quality measure assessments were conducted over the last two years to find areas where the clinic can provide needed services to the patients. Following the quality measure assessment, The Healthy Lifestyle Seminars, The Women's Health Initiative, and The Mental Health Workshop were established as monthly "pop up clinics" available to all patients. With the addition to these services coupled with a full projected 2019 year of operating three days a week our annual budget has increased and steps are needed to keep the clinic open.

With the clinic progressing, IAMACF has also made efforts in increasing its footprint in the community, and will continue to do so in the coming years. Representatives from IAMACF attended a variety of events last year including The Annual Indian American Medical Association-IL Gala, The Illinois Academy of Family Physicians Annual Meeting, and The Illinois Association of Free and Charitable Clinic Annual Meeting. This year, members of the IAMACF organization plan to take on a larger role in advocacy in the state and national level. While traditionally seeing patients at the clinic, in 2019 IAMACF plans to start health fairs, setting up in an off-site location to see patients that are not able to normally attend the clinic, and spread health education in the community. The clinic with the help of two dedicated individuals successfully wrote The American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP) AmeriCares Grant. This is the first time in the history of the AAFP that they have awarded a clinic a grant for the second time. With this grant, the clinic has already executed purchases to modernize the clinic and bring in more point of care testing. Looking forward, this clinic has set its goals to opening a fourth operational day, offering more laboratory testing, and increasing its medication formulary, all while remaining completely free to the patient. We will be able to achieve these goals with your support. In 2018 a single patient's care for the year averaged out to under \$250.00, which included four patient visits over the year and laboratory testing and medication refill.

I welcome all of you visit the clinic. You will be able to see the strides IAMACF has recently made, and the areas we are still trying to improve. I will be honored to give you a tour and show you around exactly where your contributions are being utilized. Without a doubt, you will feel the uplifting and hospitable energy within the clinic.

Thanks to each and every one of you who have contributed whether by donation or volunteer efforts, we are a necessary resource to an amazing and appreciative community. Thank you all for being part of remarkable efforts. It is a genuine pleasure to serve the community.

Message from Our Medical Director

Welcome all, to IAMACF's 25th Anniversary Gala. It is always a pleasure to see all the supporters of IAMACF Free Health Clinic. 2018 has been a good progressive year for the clinic. We have increased our participation in the community as well as the services we offer to the patients. Seeing as there is a great need in the community, in July 2018 we restarted Wednesday clinic with the help of Rosalind Franklin Medical School. On August 25th Rosen Optometry did a Free Eye clinic for the community. One of the main diseases that the South Asian community clinic faces is diabetes, the eye clinic helps to screen retinopathy as a result of diabetes. August being the "Free and Charitable Clinic" month, IAMACF Free Health clinic did an open house addressing "Life style Changes for South Asian meals". This not only educated our patients about healthy eating choices but also aids in preventative care. Additionally, IAMACF set up a booth at "Illinois Academy of Family Practice" Annual meeting on October 26th, in order to raise awareness of our organization and gain volunteer physician to help serve the community. Four members and staff attended the "Illinois Association of Free and Charitable clinics" Annual Conference on November 4th & 5th 2018. This allowed our clinic to learn the programs that other clinics are engaging in and participate in advocacy at the state and national level. In November we also worked on affiliation with "Foxglove" with Hoekton Institute which will help to bring in more volunteer physicians and receive more medications. Within IAMACF we have initiated a number of specialty clinics and workshops, two of which are the "Women's Health Initiative" started by Dr. Prema Malani and the "Mental Health Counseling Program" started by Ms. Sanjana Das. The Women's Health Initiative specifically addresses the health issues that women face. It especially understands the problems that South Asian Women face in regard to their cultural obligations which, in turn, affect their health outcomes. The Mental Health Counseling Program strives to combat the stigma in the South Asian community and provide a safe space for patients to discuss their concerns.

The clinic has made leaps and bounds towards a brighter future and will continue to do so in the coming year. One of my goals has been to steer IAMACF in the right direction as the Medical Director, my medical and non-profit experience in the past helps me to do so. Over the years, my role has changed that this clinic from overseeing Saturday volunteer medical students to overseeing more administrative responsibilities and thinking into the future of the clinic. Part of my role has also been to mentor the medical students and staff that work here at IAMACF which has been a very enjoyable experience. I am dedicated to this clinic because I can see the difference it has made for truly needy people who do not have any resources to take care of their medical problems. Our clinic is different in that we speak the patients' language, they feel more comfortable, and we understand their culture. The West Ridge community needs IAMACF and we hope to keep serving them through your support. Thank you all for attending.

Dr. George Dunea is a successful nephrologist who was born in Romania. He received his medical degree from the University of Sydney in 1957. He continued his education in both Australia and England as a resident in Internal Medicine. Dr. Dunea immigrated to the United States in 1964, working as a fellow at the Cleveland Clinic under Dr. Willem J. Kolff, the inventor and developer of renal dialysis. Following that he completed a two-year fellowship in nephrology at Presbyterian-St. Luke's Hospital in Chicago. In 1969, he became director of The Department of Nephrology and Hypertension at Cook County Hospital. In 1980 he became a professor of medicine at the University of Illinois.

Dr. Dunea has contributed to medical literature by writing chapters in several medical books and articles to many professional journals. He has applied his expertise to author and edit approximately 200 scientific and non-technical publications. In 2008, he had become the editor-in-chief of Hektoen International, which is a journal dedicated to medical humanities. A couple of his many accomplishments include being a chief founding member of the division of nephrology at Cook County Hospital and medical director of the Fresenius Dialysis Center in Chicago. One of the highlights of his career was becoming President and Chief Executive Officer of the Hektoen Institute of Medicine, where he has been since 1991. Dr. Dunea is also affiliated with several medical organizations in America and England, such as the American Medical Association, Chicago Medical Society, and the British Medical Association. His contributions to the field of medicine have garnered many awards, including a Lifetime of Service Award from the National Kidney Foundation of Illinois in 2008.

Dr. Dunea's many accomplishments and efforts have been recognized with various formal honors and awards, such as a Lifetime of Service Award from the National Kidney Foundation of Illinois in 2008. In 1995, he was elected to receive a fellowship of the American Association for the Advancement of Science. Dr. Dunea was chosen to be featured in the 44th through 70th editions of Who's Who in America, the 5th through 8th editions of Who's Who in Medicine and Healthcare, and the 23rd through 30th editions of Who's Who in the World.

Dr. George Dunea is a great contributor to the community and his work is well recognized by the medical society.

Keynote Speaker

Suja Mathew, MD, FACP is Chair of Medicine at Cook County Health (CCH) and governor of the Illinois Chapter, Northern Region of the American College of Physicians, the largest specialty-based physician organization in the country. Dr. Mathew began her career with Cook County Hospital in 2000 when she joined the staff as an attending physician in the division of general internal medicine. Her calling to the County system was marked by a strong commitment to the underserved and a desire to work for an organization with a mission to care for all individuals regardless of their ability to pay.

At Cook County Hospital, Dr. Mathew quickly established herself as an excellent clinician and educator. Though a strong affiliation with Rush Medical College, she was named course director for the Pathophysiology course for all second-year medical students. From that vantage point, she led a transformation of the Rush Medical College curriculum which culminated after her directorship completed. Following her time at Rush, she was named program director of the Stroger Hospital of Cook County internal medicine residency program in 2008. As one of the oldest and largest internal medicine programs in the country, this role was an ideal opportunity for Dr. Mathew to establish herself as a strong administrator and leader. During her

tenure, the program developed an innovative quality improvement curriculum, resident community wellness programs, and a career assistance program that led to superior fellowship and job placements.

In 2014, Dr. Mathew began her leadership of the Department of Medicine at Stroger Hospital and was named System Chair of Medicine in 2015. She currently directs internal medicine service delivery at Cook County Health, including Stroger Hospital, Provident Hospital, and a network of ambulatory centers throughout the county of Cook. She also continues to oversee the training of hundreds of residents, fellows, and medical students who rotate through Stroger Hospital's internal medicine services.

Dr. Mathew holds a number of important leadership roles regionally and nationally. She is the governor for the American College of Physicians Illinois Northern chapter and serves on the ACP national Board of Governors. She works with the American Medical Association as a practice advisor. Dr. Mathew is a sought-after speaker and teacher. She has a passion for the underserved and particular interest in the areas of social determinants of health and professional satisfaction. She is an awarded teacher and leader and a recognized humanitarian.

He also served as an Associate Chair of the Department of Medicine and chief of the Divisions of Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine at Stroger.

Dr. Shannon served as Executive Vice President and Chief Medical Officer at Parkland Health & Hospital System in Dallas from 2007-2012. In 2013 he rejoined CCH to serve as the Chief of Clinical Integration, a position in which he organized CCH resources to deliver better patient care, oversaw professional health education and helped strategically position the leadership team within the health system.

An Honorable Mention



Dr. Usha Nimmagadda

As the IAMACF nears its quarter-century mark, its board of directors looks back at the history of the organization to see what contributed to its success and consider some steps to help it reach the next level. In doing this introspective reflection, the board recognizes that one of the primary reasons for the success, has been its volunteers -from physicians, medical students to university students- who have so graciously gave their time and expertise, played a crucial role in helping the organization deliver on its promise of providing free healthcare services to anyone in need. Another fundamental reason for the organization's success has been its donors. The generosity of its donors has helped underwrite not only the purchase of its building but also many of the expenses required to operate the IAMACF free clinic. The final and perhaps less talked about reason is an equally important reason for the clinic's success. It is the role of voluntary board members who give their time, energy, money and expertise to help nurture and guide the organization to serve the community and better fulfill its mission.

In further introspection of this last role, a point of clarification must be made. This article is not meant to suggest that IAMACF board members shower praise upon each other or that they do so for self-aggrandizement reasons. On the contrary, the IAMACF board chose to highlight the contributions of one long-serving member this year, because they wanted to highlight how one member's contributions have genuinely impacted the organization and because they have also selflessly contributed their time, money and talent with no expectations in return. In simple words, this article is an honorable mention of a board member's contribution, and the benefits bestowed upon the IAMACF Free Community Health Clinic because of it. It is about a member who has so selflessly gave to help to establish the clinic's home and is now working to enhance its vision and future. In essence, it is a vow of thanks from the IAMACF board for the tireless dedication that the board member has made and continues to make to help others less fortunate. This member has not only given to the clinic, but more importantly, they have given to the community through the services of the clinic.

The individual that the IAMACF Board would like to recognize is non-other than Dr. Usha Nimmagadda, or Ushaji as other IAMACF board members affectionately know her. Dr. Nimmagadda is an Attending Anesthesiologist and Emeritus who has held many high-level positions at the Illinois Medical Center of Chicago. She is a member of several professional and social organizations, including the Illinois and American Societies of Anesthesiologists and is a founding member of the Telugu Association of Greater Chicago (TAGC) and the National Association (TANA). She is a Lecturer many times over has been credited with publishing dozens of scientific articles, exhibits, and abstracts in a variety of prestigious medical journals. She is a founding member and one of the principles of the Hindu Temple of Greater Chicago, where she has served for more than 30 years and the two terms as its President. But amazingly, all of these affiliations do not define her, as much as the philosophy she believes in: "Manav Seva is Madhav Seva" which means to "Serve humanity is to Serve God."

Dr. Usha Nimmagadda began her involvement with IAMA as a member physician in the early 2000s. At that time, the IAMA had been providing free primary healthcare services in two rooms at the Inda American

Center in Chicago. It was after observing long waiting lines at the weekend clinics that she suggested to the IAMA board that it purchase its building so that a larger free community healthcare clinic is established. You may not know this fact, but she was the leading advocate for this cause and that the IAMACF Clinic would not be in its current home if it were not for the generosity of Dr. Usha Nimmagadda and the early board members of the IAMA. Along with the substantial funds raised by the board of the IAMA-IL at the time, Dr. Usha Nimmagadda's sizeable contribution allowed the IAMA to purchase a building near the Devon community in 2002, and convert it to the six (6) room medical clinic that it is today. In making this contribution, Ushaji made only two requests: that the building is named in the memory of her late son, Sridhar Nimmagadda and that the IAMACF clinic provides free health care to underserved populations. This is the very promise, under which the IAMACF clinic operates today. It continues to be a free primary care healthcare clinic open to all regardless of race, creed, color, gender, national origin, religion, etc.

The IAMACF health clinic is located in the West Ridge neighborhood, along with its neighboring communities such as Rogers Park and Edgewater, which serve as the primary points of entry for many of Chicago's newest immigrant and refugee populations. As such, the area surrounding the IAMACF Clinic contains some of the most culturally diverse and economically challenged people in the region and includes patients from the South Asian, Asian, Latino, Eastern European, Middle Eastern and mainstream communities.

In 2009-2010, Dr. Nimmagadda served as the Chair of IAMACF, during which time the Clinic received an Outstanding Community Service Award from then-Mayor Richard M. Daley. Currently, Dr. Nimmagadda is making preparations to help the IAMACF clinic reach even higher levels of service to the community. She is making another, incredibly generous contribution by setting up a \$500,000 Endowment Fund to help the IAMACF hire its first, paid Executive Director to help expand the clinic's operational capacity, expand services and increase its hours of operations.

In the eyes of the IAMACF board and others who personally and professionally know her, Ushaji's generosity knows no boundary. Had she known that the board was even thinking of writing this honorable mention, she would have admonished us all and quickly reminded us that donating is not meant to be talked about or praised publicly. She would have further told us that giving is supposed to be a private and selfless act, quietly made, to not cause pomp or fanfare for having done so, this is because Dr. Nimmagadda is a selfless individual, who values the efforts of others, above her own. She cares for the well-being of others, less-fortunate above her own welfare. For that and more, the board members of IAMACF are genuinely humbled and inspired by her humbled generosity and spirit of service to help improve the lives of others. Her actions genuinely remind us of another great humanitarian, Mahatma Gandhi, who said: "the true measure of any society is seen in how it treats its most vulnerable members."


Asok K. Ray, M.D., FRCS Physician, Educator, Philanthropist


Even though he was an orthopedic resident at Northwestern University at the time, Dr. Ray felt very comfortable at UIC and enjoyed the camaraderie of the residents and faculty in the orthopedics department. Because of this experience, Dr. Ray always wanted to contribute something to UIC that would continue even in his absence. Endowed by his own generosity, and that of family and friends, the Asok K. Ray, M.D., FRCS Lectureship in Orthopedics fulfills that dream.

Dr. Ray completed a fellowship in orthopedic surgery at Weiss Hospital in Chicago. He served as senior resident at Children's Memorial Hospital and finished his residency as chief resident at Cook County Hospital, both in Chicago.

Since 1973 Dr. Ray has maintained a private practice at MacNeal Hospital in Chicago's western suburbs, where he organized the orthopedic department and served as its first chairman for 15 years.



During his chairmanship, the department was named one of the top 20 orthopedic departments in the United States by U.S. News and World Report. Dr. Ray also has been affiliated with Children's Memorial Hospital as a clinical professor. He has published multiple articles in the Journal of Clinical Orthopedics and Journal of Joint and Bone Surgery.



Active in philanthropy and charity work throughout his career, Dr. Ray helped build a children's cancer hospital in Calcutta, which his foundation now helps maintain. The Indira Manik Children's Hospital is the first comprehensive children's cancer hospital in India, built with funds from Dr. Asok Ray. Its equipped with fully air conditioned pediatric wards, blood bank and diagnostics, renowned pediatric oncologists, hematologist oncologists, and a team of dedicated cancer paramedics and nurses to care for the children. With a hobby center, nature parks, cartoon festivals, magic shows, toy train joyrides, etc., the pediatric patients have the best healing time possible.

He was awarded the Humanitarian of the Year Award by the Indian Medical Association in 2005 for his work for and contributions to Hurricane Katrina disaster relief.

Dr. Ray committed to providing the Helping Hand Center \$1,000,000.00 over the next five years to help with their growth initiatives, expanding quality programs and services. The Helping Hand Center is a nonprofit organization serving 750 children and adults with disabilities in suburban Cook County and greater Chicagoland communities since 1955. They offer a range of programs and services, including outpatient therapies, early intervention, a school for children with autism, high school transition, residential homes, employment services, adult day services, behavioral services, special recreation, and aging programs.

When he is not busy being a physician and with his charity work, Dr. Ray enjoys the fine arts and, sports including attending the 1996 Summer Olympics.



More recently, Dr. Asok Ray has given \$250,000 in an irrevocable trust to the Indian American Medical Association Charitable Foundation. The proceeds from this gift will go towards providing generic medications for the patients at the free clinic run by the IAMACF.


