We wanted to take a minute and thank our vendors, customers, volunteers & staff for an incredible 2nd Annual Grand Tasting on February 26th.


Thank you to our customers & visitors who attended this year. We hope lots of great new wine was discovered & relationships formed.

NEW FROM NEW ZEALAND

Dawn Chorus

New Zealand is one of the first places in the world to greet the morning sun. This fresh start is accompanied by a dawn chorus of melodic birdsong echoing from tree to tree. This sound is distinctly of its place and in forest where birdlife is flourishing this early morning wake up call can be almost deafening. Dawn Chorus makes organic Sauvignon Blanc from Hawke's Bay on the East Coast of Aotearoa- New Zealand, where the land means as much to them as the wine they put in the bottle.

2023 Dawn Chorus Sauvignon Blanc, Hawke's Bay, New Zealand

Dancing lime and lemon aromas on the nose, classic grapefruit, minerality, passionfruit, lemongrass and gold melon flavours. A bright acidity, rich palate with minerality and a hint of crunch make this a mouth filling and complex. It's a lively and ultimately drinkable Sauvignon Blanc from the East Coast of Aotearoa New Zealand.

Harvested from their grower's vineyards planted in the Wairau Valley, Malborough.2023 was a classic growing season with early refreshing rain events drying off to very little rain from February onwards. Most of the fruit ripened and was ready for harvest in early April.

2023 Front of House Sauvignon Blanc- Marlborough, New Zealand

Fresh and bright with hints of snow pea, lime skin and passionfruit aromas. The palate is rich, while still crisp, taught and lively. Flavors of tropical fruit, lemongrass, capsicum and grapefruit provide a lovely supple freshness which is balanced by a bright acidity.
