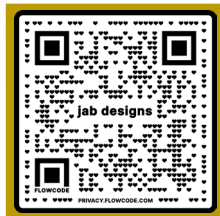

Lillie Pearl Brown Bridges Williams was born on January 23, 1937 in Gadsden County Florida, the 7th child of 14 children born to the late Ben Brown, Sr. and the late Effie Mae Blossom Brown where she attended Gadsden County Public Schools, graduating from Carter Paramore High School.

She married school mate Isaiah Harris Bridges, and to this union one daughter, Lillie Jean was born. They moved to Orlando in 1958. After working as a domestic for several years, she along with the late Mary Lee Herriott founded Peter Pan Daycare Center in 1971 where she served as Director for 45 years retiring at her 80th birthday.

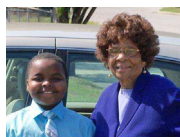
