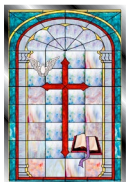

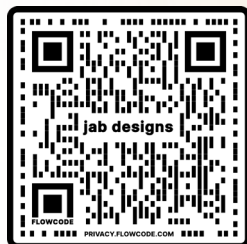

Beulah Mae Vickers Powell Monroe

A MEMOIR OF A LIFE WELL-LIVED

Beulah Vickers, the daughter of Charlie Vickers and Emma Lee Edwards, was born on June 30, 1929, in Quincy, Florida and went home to be with the Lord on May 18, 2026. Beulah was the oldest of two siblings. Her brother Charlie, Jr. preceded her in death. Beulah was happily converted at an early age and joined Mt. Moriah Missionary Baptist Church.

Beulah attended the schools of Gadsden County and Dade County, Florida, before the family relocated to Long Beach, Long Island, New York, where Beulah graduated from Long Beach High School. Beulah, affectionately called “Butch” by close family and friends, married her high school friend, Robert A. Monroe, who preceded her in death. With this union, she became the mother of five (5) children, who joined sons, Marvin and Tommy Powell, Jr.

Beulah was a Licensed Practical Nurse and worked for Nassau County Medical Center and served as a part-time Real Estate sales agent until her retirement in 1971, at which time she relocated to Orlando, Florida. She united with Shiloh Baptist Church and remained there until she became a founding member of the New Covenant Baptist Church of Orlando, where she remained until she went to be with the Lord.

Beulah provided travel services to the community through her travel agency, ABS Travel Services. She was also a member of the City of Orlando Municipal Planning Board, a New Covenant Trustee, Usher, Youth Leader, Evangelism Team Member, Choir and Finance Committee Member, and Co-Chair member of the Missions Ministry, the President of Silver Strands, Church Treasurer, and on the Executive Council. Beulah was feisty with a direct and outspoken personality, and loved traveling and fishing in her spare time.

Beulah was also preceded in death by her **son** – Robert C. Jr., and is survived by six of her seven **children** – Tommie, Marvin, Godfrey, Clayton, Keith and Veronica; fourteen (14) **grandchildren**; fourteen (14) **great-great grandchildren**; a **special niece** – Dr. Sylvia P. Braswell; **special friends** – Bessie Henderson, Stella Lewis, and Eliza Lopes; a **special godson** – Robert E. Cleveland, Jr.; **nephew** – B.
