



Eddie Franklyn Rodriguez



Eddie Franklyn Rodriguez—known lovingly as “*Big Eddie*”—was born in Ponce, Puerto Rico, and peacefully entered the presence of his Lord on December 9, 2025, in Orlando, Florida, at the age of 87.

Eddie was many things: a devoted husband, a father and dad, a proud grandpa and great-grandpa, a mechanic with gifted hands, a teacher by nature, and above all, a man who deeply loved Jesus Christ. To know Eddie was to know warmth, wisdom, and a well-timed joke. He was friendly, caring, hardworking, purposeful, and original—never a copy of anyone else. His greatest aim was simple and steady: to do what was *right* in the eyes of the Lord.

Music was Eddie’s secret fuel. Turn on a song and his shoulders would start rocking, his feet tapping, and his fingers magically transformed into drumsticks—keeping perfect rhythm, of course. Saturdays were sacred for ice cream runs, a tradition he took *very* seriously. Sundays were even more special, as they were reserved for worship and time with his church family, whom he loved dearly.

Eddie had a Masters degree in Business Administration, but preferred to work 25 years as an expert automotive technician for Alamo Enterprise, fixing what was broken and teaching others how to do the same. Beyond his career, he faithfully volunteered with Prison Fellowship Ministry, preaching and sharing the Word of God with inmates. His deepest passion was seeing men grow into real men—men of faith, integrity, strength, and purpose—exactly as God designed them to be.

Eddie was preceded in death by his **parents** – Herminio Rodriguez (a saxophonist!) and Donatila Perez; his **son** – Ramon; and the **mother of his children** – Isabel Rodriguez. He is survived by his beloved **wife** – Rosalina; his **children** – Edith, Jose, and Francisco and Cassie; and his **bonus children** – Darlyn, Harry, and Rose. Eddie also leaves behind his cherished **grandchildren** – Nicole, Luz Elaine, Micheal, Felisha, and Antonio, and his **great-grandchildren** – Ka’Jon, Keonna, Bella, and Savanah, each of whom brought him immense pride and joy.

Eddie’s life was a living sermon: steady, joyful, and grounded in faith. While his hands are now at rest and his fingers no longer drum along to the beat, heaven has gained a faithful servant—and undoubtedly, the rhythm just got better.

He will be deeply missed, fondly remembered, and joyfully reunited one day with those who loved him.
