Eunice met and married the love of her life, Jessie Windom, in 1963. They eventually moved to Orlando, Florida. To this union 4 children were born.


Eunice received training as a medical assistant, and obtained certification in that field. She worked for many years as a Corrections Officer, until her retirement.


