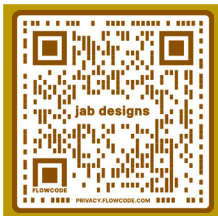

Akelia Lauryn Taylor, born on June 21, 1998 at St. Ann’s Bay Hospital in Jamaica, embraced life with unmatched zest. After moving to Florida as a toddler, she flourished academically, attending Robinswood Middle and Ocoee High School.

Akelia worked hard to make sure she had good grades, crying profusely about failing even BEFORE starting all her courses. But it was this honorable fear of failure, and her desire to make her mom proud, that pushed her to be hardworking and dedicated. And when she went on to Valencia to pursue a career in nursing, she also cried her way through and came out victorious! Realizing her dream, Akelia worked at Advent Health Hospital as an RN until her passing.

Akelia was a shy child, and soft-spoken, but she had the most contagious smile. She LOVED life! And she loved traveling back and forth to her native Jamaica, often dancing with joy. She loved listening to Reggae music, shopping, and trying out new perfumes.

Unbeknownst to her family, Akelia had registered herself as an organ donor. Through her heroic bravery she was able to save 4 lives, 3 of whom were considered critical. Akelia will always be remembered for her warmth and the lives she touched.

Left behind to cherish memories of a life well-lived: her **mother** – Pauline Morse; her **father** – Rufus Taylor; **brother** – Vernoy “Junior” Spence; and a host of **aunts, uncles, cousins**, other relatives, and many friends who loved her.
