Lorraine Alice Johnson, affectionately known as “Sissy,” was born on November 15, 1965, in Orlando, Florida. As the youngest of four, she quickly claimed her special place in the family—and in the heart of her grandfather “Gramp,” the Late Louie Lee Troy Kelly. He adored her and helped shape the gentle strength she carried throughout her life.

Sissy was soft-spoken, but don’t let that fool you—when she spoke, *everyone* listened. From early on, she knew who she was and what she wanted. While the other children preferred doing dishes, Sissy chose the kitchen—not to clean it, but to MASTER it. Cooking became her love language, and in true Sissy fashion, everything had to be just so. If it wasn’t perfect, it didn’t get served. That same spirit of order, excellence, and care followed her throughout every season of her life.

A proud graduate of Oak Ridge High School (Class of 1983), she went on to study business at Bethune-Cookman University. With that foundation, she built a meaningful career managing medical offices—always balancing professionalism with compassion. She didn’t just *run* a business....she *cared* for the people behind the paperwork, especially the elderly. Her heart was wide open, and her hands were always giving—whether it was food, time, encouragement, or just a warm smile to a stranger on the street.

Sissy was a proud and devoted mother—her children’s biggest cheerleader and provider. Family was everything to her, and she didn’t just say it—she *lived* it. Blending families, feeding contractors, welcoming friends and strangers alike—she kept love and order at the center of it all.

Raised in a Christian home, Sissy carried the Gospel in her heart and in her home. Sundays were sacred—filled with the sounds of The Winans Family and Donnie McClurkin. Her favorite reminder echoed often: “*God sits high and looks low. Do right, and RIGHT will follow you.*” In her later years, you could see her walk with the Lord deepen, her quiet strength turning into a radiant faith.

Everything about Sissy said order—her meals, her career, her values, and her legacy. And yet, within all that order was warmth, joy, and the kind of love that fills a home and feeds a soul.
