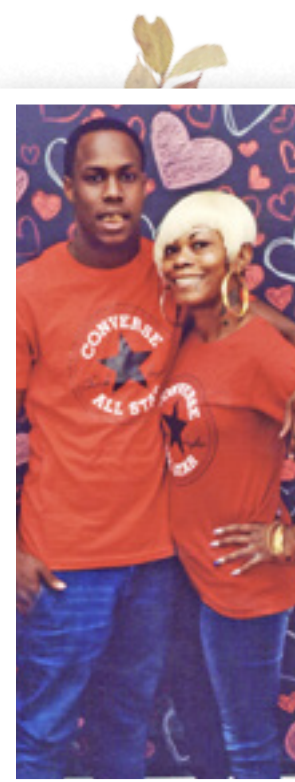

When I look in the mirror, it's you that I see, because you reflect a split image of me. A testimony of my clone, with matching features to the bone, you resemble me down to the tee.

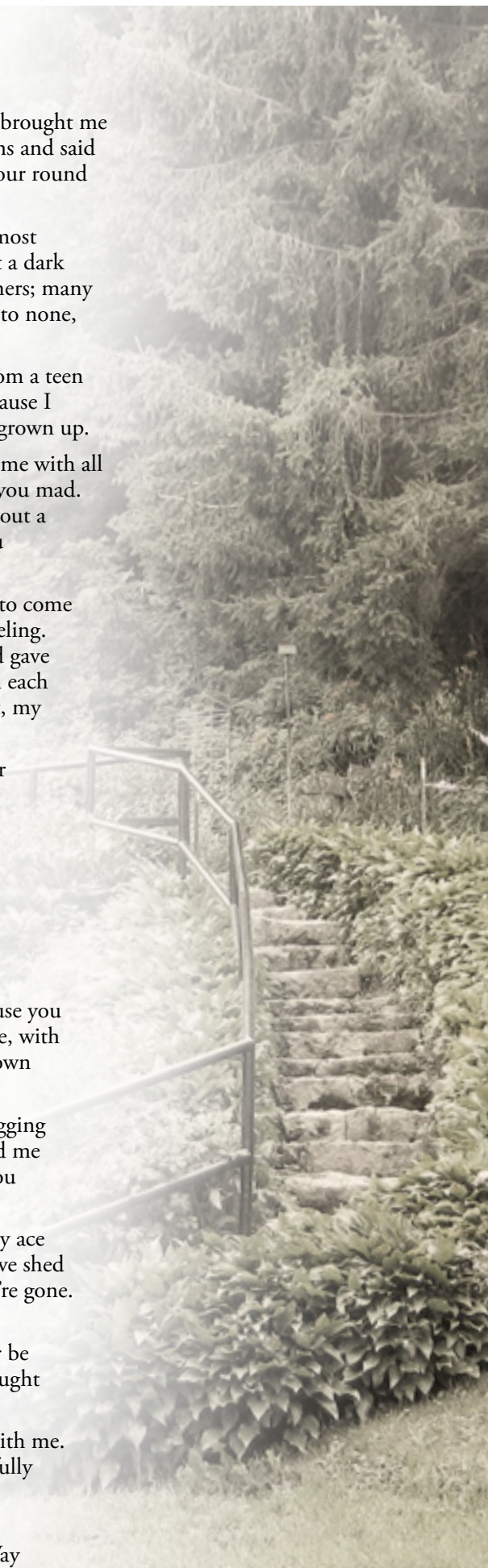
