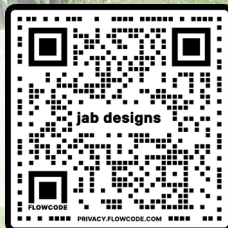

## Quinton Enrique Roberts

Born on September 7, 1928, in St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands, **Quinton Enrique “Quint” Roberts** was the cherished son of the late Richard and Albertine Roberts. From a young age, he embraced his faith and became a life-long member of Holy Family Episcopal Church. Later in Orlando, he served the Lord with dedication as an usher, groundskeeper, and as vice president of the Young at Heart Ministry, where his kindness and spirit touched many.

Quinton’s devotion to service continued in 1950, when he proudly enlisted in the U.S. Air Force, serving as a Teletype Mechanic for 8 years. After his military service, he continued to serve his community through his work with the Port Authority, and later in Public Works, always working diligently in quiet humility.

In New York, Quinton was reunited with Grace, a childhood friend who would become the love of his life. Together, they created a beautiful life, marrying in Puerto Rico, living in the Virgin Islands, New York, and finally settling in Orlando, Florida. Their bond grew strong over nearly 54 years of marriage, love, and partnership.

A man of simple pleasures, Quinton was deeply passionate about gardening, reading, and his love for jazz. His gentle nature and love for life’s quieter moments defined him.

Quinton was preceded in death by his five **sisters** and one **brother**.

He leaves to cherish his memory: his **devoted wife** – Grace Roberts; his **stepdaughter** – Bernadette Gaillard; his attentive **godchildren and neighbors** – Lewis and Jacqueline Coleman; and a host of other loving relatives and friends who will always remember him for the kindness and joy he brought into their lives.

Though he is no longer with us, Quinton’s memory will live on in the hearts of all who had the privilege of knowing him. He was a true example of faith, humility, and love—a life well-lived.
