

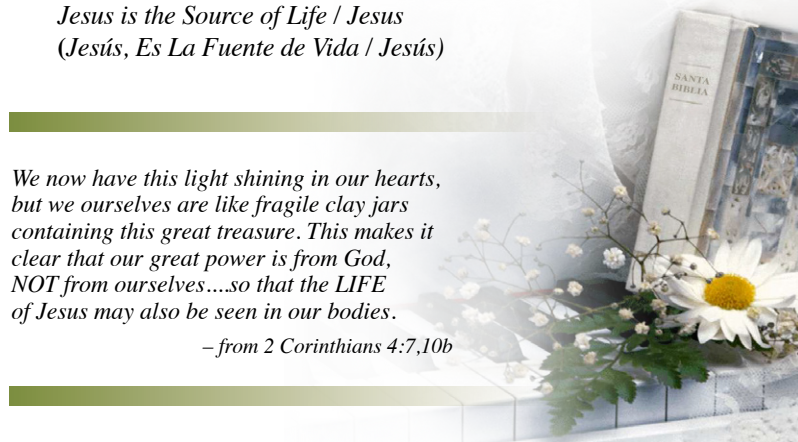

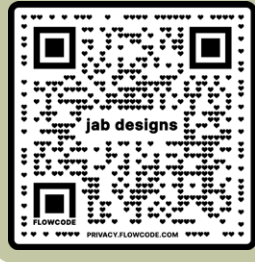


In Appreciation
