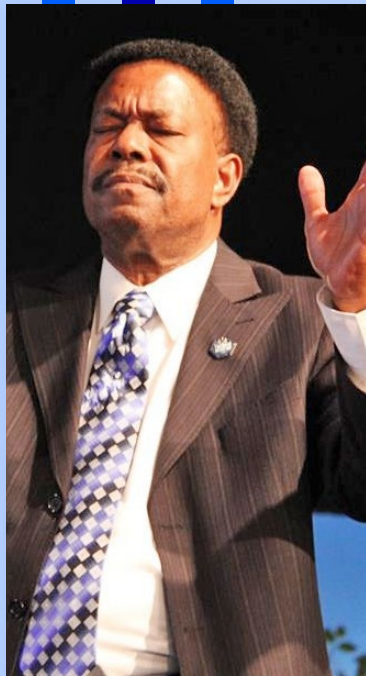

Bishop Willie B. Johnson was born November 19, 1947, in Eastman, Georgia, to the late Annie Mae Johnson and Willie Andrew Johnson. He lived a life marked by faith, service, and devotion to both God and family.

After completing his formative education, Bishop Johnson honorably served his country in the United States Army, earning several commendations including the Purple Heart Medal and National Defense Service Medal, achieving the rank of Sergeant before his honorable discharge in 1971.

His greatest calling, however, was ministry.

In 1986, Bishop Johnson married Dr. Denise H. Johnson, and together they stepped into the calling God had placed upon their lives. Soon afterward, they attended Rhema Bible Training College in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, preparing for ministry. Bishop Johnson was licensed and ordained by the late Bishop Isaiah Williams of Jesus People Ministries in Miami, Florida, and later ordained through Rhema Bible Training College.

With a vision rooted in Ephesians 4:12—to equip the saints for the work of ministry—Bishop Johnson faithfully taught believers to seek first the Kingdom of God and grow in the knowledge of His Word.

On January 19, 1991, that vision gave birth to Faith Fellowship Family Church, which began in the Johnson family home. From those humble beginnings, the ministry grew through several seasons and locations, later becoming Orlando Faith Ministries International, and in 2013 moving into its current location. In 2024, the ministry was established as Faith Haven Church.

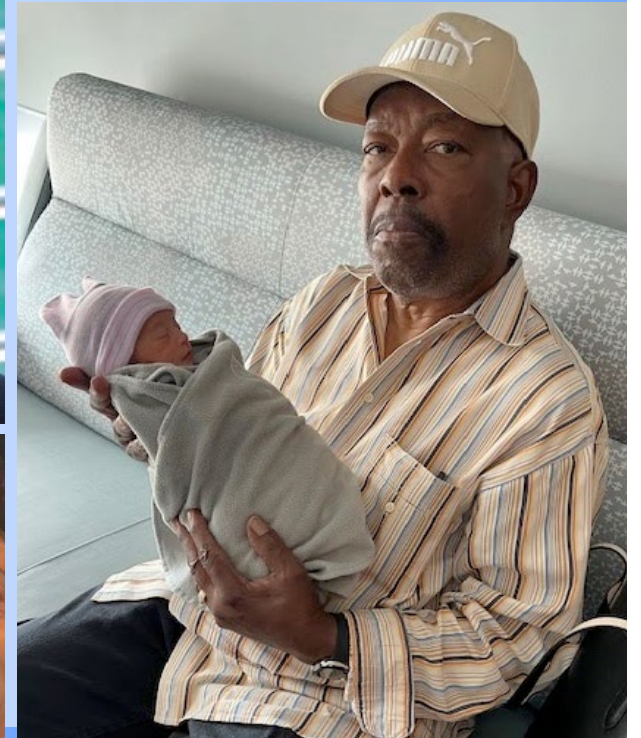
For more than three decades, Bishop Johnson served as a faithful shepherd and teacher, pouring wisdom, encouragement, and spiritual guidance into countless lives. Many remember the words he often shared with unwavering faith: *"When you can't track Him, when you can't trace Him, you trust Him!"*

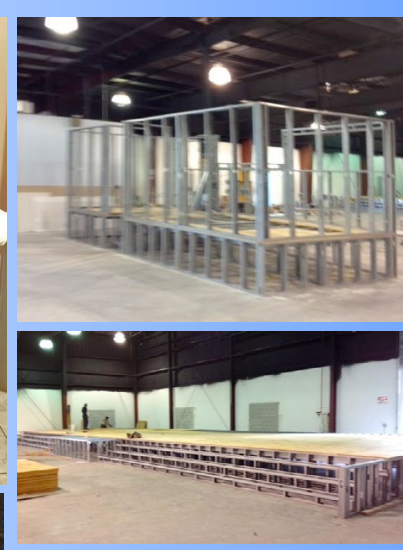
Beyond the pulpit, Bishop Johnson was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, brother, and friend. He loved studying the Word of God and cherished time with his family, especially his grandchildren, who were truly the apple of his eye.

He was preceded in death by his **parents**, Annie Mae Johnson and Willie Andrew Johnson; and **siblings** – Andrew C. Johnson, James Johnson, Ruthie Lee Johnson, Nettie Mae Johnson, Gloria Johnson, Ollie B. Johnson, Otis Henry Johnson, and Mertice Wright.

Bishop Johnson leaves behind many beautiful memories of a life well-lived. His legacy continues through his beloved **wife** – Dr. Denise H. Johnson; his **sons** – Willie Johnson, Chadwick Johnson, Antron Johnson, Daniel (Deanna) Johnson, and David (Adriana) Johnson; his **sister** – Venearee Johnson; his **grandchildren** whom he loved dearly; and a host of **nieces, nephews, cousins**, other relatives, colleagues, church family, and many friends.

Though his voice is now quiet, the Word he taught still speaks. The foundation he built through faith, leadership, and love will continue to inspire generations to come.

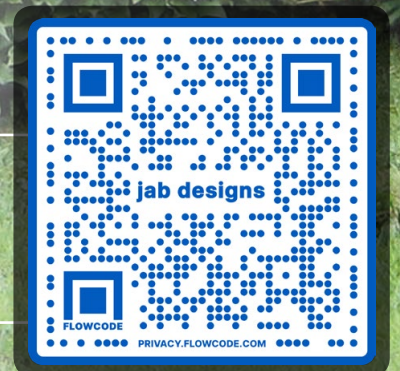
