


Sponsor Sweet Dreams



Message from the Spiritual Director

Love, Love, Love, Love

Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails.

1 Corinthians 13: 4-8a

It's that time of year again — February. And isn't it appropriate that this year Ash Wednesday falls on Valentine's Day. As we prepare our hearts to celebrate the highest and holiest of holidays in the Christian faith — Resurrection Sunday on Easter morning we are reminded that it all began with love. "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." John 3:16

As I recall my original Walk weekend and reflect on the Walks that I have been able to serve on, either on live-in team or as a part of this Greater Dayton Emmaus Community, the one ingredient that makes it all work is Love. Love is the secret sauce. I know we say throughout the weekend "don't anticipate." Nevertheless, I am here to tell you that the one thing you can anticipate is that Jesus Loves You!

I remember the first Gathering that I attended as a guest before I had gone on my Walk. The Fourth Day speaker said that he had two goals for his Walk weekend — he wanted "to hear from God and he wanted to see God." Then through tear-filled eyes and a joyful voice he declared, "and I did." Isn't that good news? It is amazing to me what God can do with a few sold out servants who are in love with Jesus.

There's a Walk weekend this month, so don't miss your opportunity to show someone else what love is all about. When you help with set-up or tear-down you are showing God's love. When you get up at 2am to pray for the Pilgrims and Team by name, you are showing God's love. When you come to make or sort gifts of agape, you are showing God's love. When you come to cook a meal, cut up fruit, load the dishwasher and reset the tables, you are showing God's love. When you agree to sponsor a Pilgrim and pray for them and take care of outside family concerns so that they can be fully present for the Walk, you are showing God's love. And when you come to a candle-light service to "let your light shine so they see Him and so they may know that our God of love's in the land," you are showing God's love.

So let's not wait until February to get in this game called love. "Love, love, love, love, love, the gospel in one word is love. Love your neighbor as your sister (brother), love, love, love."




Prayer Vigil
