Notes from the Spiritual Director

The Gift of Motherhood

Mothers significantly impact a child's life. Beyond bringing the child into the world, a mother's role is crucial to the child's development.

Many young girls aspire to become mothers. The thought of nurturing an infant is both exciting and overwhelming. From the endless nights without sleep to the constant feedings and addressing their discomfort or illness, being a mother entails tremendous responsibility. This responsibility doesn't end with infancy; as the child grows, they go through various developmental stages, and you are there as a guide, protector, and teacher. Additionally, providing emotional support is crucial for children to grow into respectful and responsible adults. Out of obedience, she responded to the news, "I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May your word to me be fulfilled." Being a mother is a special gift that is not given to everyone. Your child may have already reached adulthood, yet it's never too late to redeem the time. Share your faith, show your love, and remind them of the blessings that they are, the gift from God.

To all the mothers out there, embrace this precious gift of love that God has allowed you to bring into the world, and be an example of a godly mother- one who loves God and loves others.


