
Matthew 13:49-50 NIV

The United States has been experiencing intense hot weather. Heat alerts have been issued, warning people to be cautious when going outside. Extreme heat is becoming common and seems unstoppable. Excessive heat can harm health, so it's very important to stay safe during these times.
