# SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR



Every year, my church celebrates the Lenten season. This year's Lenten season begins on Valentine's Day, which was initially a Christian feast day, but has been represented as a day of romantic love, an eros kind of love.

With Lent beginning on February 14th, it is an opportunity to remember God's agape love. God showed love for us by giving us redemption through His Son, Jesus Christ.

We begin our service by placing ashes on the foreheads of those who attend with these words; "from dust, thou art, and to dust you shall return." The ashes are from the palm branches from last year's Palm Sunday and are placed in the sign of the cross as a reminder that Jesus died on the cross for our sins.

Lent marks a solemn occasion, a time of denial, reflection, and meditation, although not a Biblical mandate but an excellent opportunity to connect or, in some cases, reconnect and build one's relationship with the Lord. For forty days (which does not include Sundays; however, some continue their devotion forty-six days to include Sundays), devoted worshippers seek to build their relationship with God, honoring Him through fasting, prayer, and abstinence, ridding themselves of distractions and focusing more on God.

As we enter this season of denial and reflection, I'm reminded of one of the songs we often sing at our Emmaus gatherings: "The Gospel in One Word Is Love." What an excellent opportunity to show that love through sacrifice, demonstrating His love, and serving others. In this season, let us focus on His love, the agape kind of love that was then is now and forevermore.



The new train-of-thought is to have sponsors/ pilgrims and team provide their own cot or air mattress.


