
My husband and I have prayed daily together in the morning before we go our separate ways for over 25 years. Part of our prayers include getting spiritually dressed with the scripture passage below.

MEN'S WALK POSTPONED

Dear Emmaus Community,

It is with a heavy heart that we have made the decision to postpone the January Men's Walk 71 until the weekend of June 27-30th 2024 at Sulphur Grove Church in Huber Heights.

I wanted to dispel any rumors about the reasoning behind this decision. It was not made lightly. It was made with prayerful consideration for the best outcome for our community. While it may seem to some that it was made quickly, I want to assure you that it was made for the benefit of all of the community. Many, many hours of discussion, prayers, meetings and deliberation to come to this decision. We have needed to postpone walks prior to this occasion, and just as in those cases, it was in the hope of providing the best experience for the men who will attend this walk. This decision was made due to the reasons which I will explain here.

The first reason is the number of confirmed pilgrims for this walk. The Men's Registrar reported that we had just eight men who had agreed to be on the walk. As a community, we were hoping to extend the deadline for applications until December 22nd in the hope that we could get the number needed for a walk, however, even with outstanding applications, our number was only five additional people who we were waiting on applications and confirmation. Even if all of those pilgrims were confirmed, that gives us 13 pilgrims which is not even halfway to our goal.

Our desire is always to have a full walk. It is designed to have 30 pilgrims. This is an important aspect as when we have fewer than 30 pilgrims it changes the table dynamics, as there is a stronger need to rely on the table leaders and assistant table leaders to help with discussions. It also can strain the table bonds after the walk to form share groups as the table leaders are already in established share groups.

As a community we have agreed that a minimum of 20 pilgrims is needed for us to fund the walk. As you can see, we can not rely on unconfirmed numbers. We made this decision based on the number of confirmed and committed pilgrims.

The second reason for this decision was because of the sudden and unexpected need to find replacements for the team. It is very common for the team formation process to experience changes, after all it is God's weekend and we serve at His pleasure. The team meetings had already started but due to unforeseen circumstances, many of the volunteers we rely on to hold walks needed to drop from the team for a variety of reasons including health, work and family commitments. We felt that the tight timing of the approaching holidays and the availability and necessity for cohesive team meetings did not allow for volunteers to prayerfully consider joining the team. The ability to have a committed, cohesive team is essential for all of the spiritual challenges that can happen during a walk weekend.

It is expected to have a few changes during the team formation process, however, with the upcoming holidays, this was a challenge that had not been faced before. Following the Emmaus guidelines, the leadership of the community and the walk discussed the challenges and how to best serve the community.

The postponement of the walk allows both the pilgrim numbers and team challenges the time needed to be resolved. As we all know, things happen on God's time, not ours. We all want the walks to bring the pilgrims closer to knowing the love of Christ. We all need to do our part for the success of the walk weekends.

Right now there are not enough pilgrims to have a Women's Walk in February, we currently have nine confirmed pilgrims for Women's Walk #111 We have some additional time, however, the deadline is quickly approaching and we may need to postpone this walk as well. We need your help!

As a community it is important that we have good sponsors who are able to fulfill all the duties needed for a walk weekend. Our guidelines state that a sponsor should only have one pilgrim and if they have more than one pilgrim that the sponsor should have a co-sponsor to help with the duties. Team members are also discouraged from sponsoring pilgrims unless they have another Emmaus brother or sister to attend to sponsor duties while on the walk. Our pilgrims are only as strong as our sponsors and the duty and privilege of a sponsor can not be taken lightly. Please follow this <u>link for sponsorship information</u> about sponsorship.

Our walk weekends rely on the live-in team to be successful. The team process begins with the willing servant form. Each position that you would be interested in serving on should be marked on that form - linked here.




