YOU WASH, I'LL DRY

A NOTE FROM THE SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

"Just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many" Matthew 20:28

"I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you." John 13:15

Did you ever notice that serving is contagious? Just hang around an Emmaus Walk Weekend and you will see what I'm talking about. First your sponsor picks you up at your house to chauffeur you and carries your luggage to the car. When you arrive at the church someone grabs your luggage and escorts you to your luxurious accommodations and helps you make your bed.



Then it's on to the dining hall, where someone else has prepared and set out a light meal for send-off—which includes having someone serve you drinks, followed by clearing your plate from the table. Throughout the weekend you see glimpses of people joining in behind the scenes to serve.

Someone arrives before sunrise and sets the table, someone cooks breakfast, someone serves breakfast, someone makes the coffee and serves the drinks; someone does the dishes, cleans the kitchen and re-sets the table for lunch.

During the short break you discover that someone has cleaned the bathrooms (toilets and showers and sinks) since the morning rush.

Someone cooks lunch, serves lunch including seconds and drinks tableside. Someone cleans all of that up, does the dishes again and starts prepping for the dinner meal.

Don't look now, but meanwhile back in the conference room, someone has emptied the trash and put out water and pop and snacks. By dinner time you may be ready to join in the serving fun, but no, they won't let you. "Let me," they say, "I've got that."

You begin to notice that throughout the weekend, people show up simply to serve. They might come in to sing a special song at chapel, or to do a dramatic reading that makes the scriptures come alive, or to perform a praise dance that makes your heart leap as you imagine Mary pouring her oil from her box of alabaster.

Someone else shows up to pray in the chapel for a team member while they give their talk; or someone else shows up with blankets because they heard the sleeping area was a little chilly.

Why would all these servants show up, anonymously, for just a few moments or a few hours to serve? Why would they get up at 2am to pray for someone they don't even know? Well, could it be because serving is contagious? Could it be because they saw it done for them and now they just have to pass it on? "I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you."

You don't have to wait for an Emmaus Walk to start serving. You can start tonight at home. Walk into the kitchen and grab a towel and say, "you wash, I'll dry."



Effective with the July 2024 walk, prices will now be:

Pilgrims - \$25 initial fee + \$100 -- Total \$125

Live-in Team - \$90
