NOW WHAT?

WHEN THE SABBATH WAS OVER, MARY MAGDALENE, AND MARY THE MOTHER OF JAMES, AND SALOME BOUGHT SPICES, SO THAT THEY MIGHT GO AND ANOINT HIM. AND VERY EARLY ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE WEEK, WHEN THE SUN HAD RISEN, THEY WENT TO THE TOMB. THEY HAD BEEN SAYING TO ONE ANOTHER, "WHO WILL ROLL AWAY THE STONE FOR US FROM THE ENTRANCE TO THE TOMB?"

WHEN THEY LOOKED UP, THEY SAW THAT THE STONE, WHICH WAS VERY LARGE, HAD ALREADY BEEN ROLLED BACK. AS THEY ENTERED THE TOMB, THEY SAW A YOUNG MAN, DRESSED IN A WHITE ROBE, SITTING ON THE RIGHT SIDE; AND THEY WERE ALARMED. BUT HE SAID TO THEM, "DO NOT BE ALARMED; YOU ARE LOOKING FOR JESUS OF NAZARETH, WHO WAS CRUCIFIED. HE HAS BEEN RAISED; HE IS NOT HERE. LOOK, THERE IS THE PLACE THEY LAID HIM. BUT GO, TELL HIS DISCIPLES AND PETER THAT HE IS GOING AHEAD OF YOU TO GALILEE; THERE YOU WILL SEE HIM, JUST AS HE TOLD YOU." SO THEY WENT OUT AND FLED FROM THE TOMB, FOR TERROR AND AMAZEMENT HAD SEIZED THEM; AND THEY SAID NOTHING TO ANYONE, FOR THEY WERE AFRAID. MARK 16:1-8A | NRSV



The consensus among biblical scholars is that Mark is the oldest of the four gospels and that in its original form it ended in 16:8a. Verses 8b thru 20 were added at a later date. So, if you were a newbie follower of Jesus in the first century and read Mark's earliest description of Easter morning, what would you make of it all? Like the two Marys and Salome, terror-filled and amazed, would you too, be dumbstruck?

A tried and true method of studying Scripture is to ask and attempt to answer three questions: "What, So What, and Now What?"; I.e., "What's going on here?', "What did it mean for the people in the story?", and, "What does it mean for us today and how are we going to live differently because of it?" Mark's narrative tells us the "What" answer, but fails to inform us of the "So What?". We are left clueless as to what the two Marys and Salome understood the empty tomb to mean. Nearly 2,000 years later, are we also dumbstruck? What's our "Now What?"

Over the many years of my ongoing faith journey I have been blessed with many Spirit-filled mentors along the way. One is the Rev. Ed Zeiders, a kind, gentle, and inspiring man of faith. Ed was president of United Theological Seminary when I was a student. He has eloquently answered the "Now What?" of the empty tomb—what Easter can mean to us today and in all the days to come:

"The Church understands that we are the movement of people who result from the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. We are in the world as recipients and agents of God's grace. We live, move, and have our being in the Spirit of the Living Lord—Easter People set apart and differentiated by the Gospel, in all humility, to proclaim the Good News of God's victory over sin and death, the release of the captives, and the freedom to move about as the evidence of God's grace and mercy.'

May all of us, as Easter People, strive to be the best evidence of God's grace and mercy that we can be in a world today that so desperately needs to experience it!

Some of you may be wondering what TSC stands for?

TSC is for Team Selection Committee and running the committee is one of the responsibilities of the Vice Chairman. I work along with four other people chosen by the Past Chairman, the Chairman of the Board and one of our four spiritual directors.

The Computer Chair gives the group a list of names for each position on the Men's and Women's live-in teams to review.

The names are vetted by the committee and then given to Lay Directors for them to call and see if they are willing to serve on a live-in team for the next men's or women's walk.

Since there have been several years without walks because of COVID, we are asking everyone to submit a NEW willing servant form to ensure we have the latest information in our database.

The Lay Directors for our upcoming summer men's and women's walks having been trying to call folks from our community to serve and have found that some phone numbers and emails are no longer correct.

If you would like to serve on a live-in team, I ask you to fill out a NEW willing servant form and check those positions you'd like to serve in. Please note that for your first live-in team, you must serve as an assistant table leader before you can serve in any other live-in capacity

If you do not wish to serve on a live-in team, we would love for you to serve in our Emmaus Community in other ways.

We need help in the kitchen, housing, Worship Committee and in other behind-the-scenes jobs to help make our walks happen and also at Gatherings.

We will have sign-ups at Gatherings or come talk to any of our board members. We can help you find those in charge of those areas of need.

Remember--The walks cannot happen with out the help of the Emmaus community. We are one team. We are also thankful for the churches that allow us to use their buildings to allow walk weekends, Gatherings, and board and committee meetings to happen.

Our Men's live-in team has just started meetings and they are excited to be able to serve the community and the pilgrims that will be on this upcoming men's walk June 23rd to 26th.
