

GOLDEN OPPORTUNITY!

Is the Lord preparing you and calling you to lead a future Emmaus Walk as a Lay Director (LD)?

If so, the Lord prepares you by deepening your faith and through a series of progressive servanthood positions on Emmaus Walks from Assistant Table Leader, two walks as a Table Leader with talks, two additional walks as an Assistant Lay Director with talks at least, and possibly serving as a Logistics, Prayer Servant, or Assistant Music Director on additional walks. The Lay Director process is a 6-month process to build a team of about 30 people, with lots of prayer, 6 team meetings, and a number of pre-meetings. It is a powerful, spiritual, faith deepening time while you build the team the Lord has pulled together through you and He walks side by side with you through all the decisions you need to make with His guidance.

In addition, all those called to be Lay Directors complete a 7-hour Lay Director Training within 18 months of the walk they will lead as an LD. This training is offered two times a year, once in the Spring at Sulphur Grove UMC and once in the Fall at Normandy UMC. The next Lay Director Training will be held on Saturday, October 16, from 9 am to 4 pm at Normandy UMC in the children's education classrooms on a lower floor at the back of the church.
