Interest-Free Microloans for Small Businesses: Our mission to defeat poverty includes empowering entrepreneurs through zero-interest microloans. During our stay in Benin City, we visited several community-based business centers that were launched through this initiative, and we monitored the progress in various small businesses we helped launch:

We monitored their progress, offered business mentorship, and identified further needs for training and support. These businesses are not just sources of income—they are engines of dignity, purpose, and transformation for families who once had nothing.

♥ A Heartbreaking Reminder **♥**

One family we visited left us shaken. *Mrs. Joy Johnson*, a restaurant owner and guardian to four grandchildren, lost one of her 9-year-old twins due to ignorance and poor healthcare decisions. The surviving twin was severely malnourished. We immediately provided **eggs and milk**, and we are committed to ongoing support for her remaining grandchildren





Hospital Outreach and Medical Supplies



University of Benin Teaching Hospital (UBTH) Partnership



At **UBTH**, we supported both patients and healthcare staff through meaningful donations and demonstrations:

Stroke Unit Incontinence Care

- Demonstrated use of **Zinc Oxide Barrier Cream**
- Donated adult diapers and bed protection pads

Accident & Emergency Unit

- Donated:
 - Wrist restraints (for violent/restless patients)
 - Laryngoscopes (for intubation)
 - o N-95 masks (for infection control)
- Demonstrated proper restraint technique to staff



This partnership embodies our commitment to improving healthcare infrastructure and uplifting medical personnel.





Medical Outreach in Ekiti State

Healing the Sick ✓ | Restoring Dignity ✓ | Saving Lives ✓

Between April and May 2025, Love Your Neighbor Rescue Mission International embarked on a transformative mission to Nigeria, reaching some of the most underserved communities with love, practical support, and hope. Our journey began in **Ekiti State**, a region where many indigent families lack access to even the most basic healthcare services.

With our partnership with Prohealth International, volunteer healthcare professionals and generous donors, we were able to conduct a **massive free medical outreach**, serving over **6,000 individuals**.



Services Delivered:

- Eye Care: Eye exams, treatments, and distribution of reading and prescription glasses to those with impaired vision.
- **Dental Services:** Teeth Extractions, fillings, free insertion of dentures, and oral hygiene education for both adults and children.
- General **Surgery:** Emergency and elective minor and major general surgeries for hernias, hydroceles, Lipomas, uterine fibroids, enlarged thyroids, undescended testicles, lumps, orthopedic cases, Caesarian section deliveries, and other conditions that had long gone untreated.
- Laboratory Testing: Screenings for malaria, hepatitis, HIV, and other critical conditions were conducted onsite
- Pharmaceutical Services: Free pharmaceutical supplies and medications were dispensed to all patients in need
- General Consultations: Diagnosis and treatment of common illnesses such as malaria, typhoid, diabetes, hypertension, and respiratory infections.

Our medical tents bustled with hope, our mobile clinics provided urgent care, and the gratitude from the community filled the air.

Many received life-saving treatments they would never have otherwise accessed.



Fighting Malaria: M Awareness & Prevention Initiatives



In partnership with trained nurses from the University of Benin Teaching Hospital, Love Your Neighbor hosted a comprehensive Malaria Prevention Health Fair in Benin City. This event included:

Health Education Sessions on how to identify, prevent, and treat malaria.

Free Distribution of Insecticide-Treated Mosquito Nets and Insecticides to hundreds of households.

A community-wide Street Walk titled "Malaria Prevention Awareness", where our volunteers and medical staff distributed informative flyers to hundreds of passersby.

Malaria remains a leading cause of illness and death in Nigeria, particularly among children and pregnant women. Our goal is not only to treat malaria but to stop it before it starts. This campaign reached hundreds of families and will continue through our local partners throughout the year.

Farm to Table Agricultural Program

Farming for the Future: Cultivating Hope in Benin City

Nourishing Bodies and Minds: After wrapping up our work in Ekiti, our team proceeded to Benin City, Edo State, where we visited our Hope for Success Empowerment Farm—a vital part of our long-term strategy to promote food security and community resilience.

With love and labor, we harvested:

- Tomatoes
- T Palm fruits
- No Plantains
- Green leafy vegetables

These fresh organic farm products were immediately distributed to **vulnerable families** in abject poverty registered with our organization.


