We rescue and empower families that live below poverty level by giving them microloans without interest. These families can support their families with food and pay their children’s school fees.

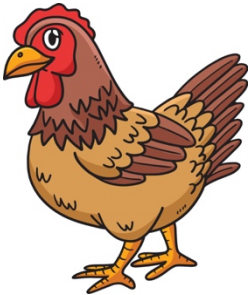
SMALL-SCALE

Love Your Neighbor Farm Project

April 2024

We have 100 plots (16.7 Acres) of land shared between our Plantain and Palm plantations that were planted in 2023. These crops are growing nicely because of the assistance of laborers employed to work on the farm along with our rescued families. In a few months, we shall begin to harvest some plantains to feed our rescued families.

Two huts are currently under construction within the farm settlement where our laborers and rescued families could stay when they are on the farm. These families are very grateful to our donors for their love and support. They can't wait to reap the fruits of their labors.

Love Your Neighbor Farmland is in Urgent need of:

Building a borehole system to supply water for the farmers who live within the farm settlement. The borehole system is the only feasible way to get water to the farmers.
