INTRODUCTION

Our mission trip to Nigeria was quite an undertaking. We arrived in the beautiful city of Benin City, on June 21, 2023. On June 24th, the leadership, and volunteers of Love Your Neighbor Rescue Mission International visited our school children at Oba Ewuare Elementary School where we have 30 pupils that Love Your Neighbor support. We also visited our farmland of plantain and palm plantations. On the first day, we drove through the bush of ungraded and unpaved road to access our farmland of 25 Acres of land. Love Your Neighbor's mission also includes giving of micro-loans to families in abject poverty for creation of small businesses, and medical outreaches to the College of Nursing students at the University of Benin Teaching Hospital (U.B.T.H.).



Love Your Neighbor's Mission also includes giving of micro-loans to families in abject poverty. These loans are given without any interest paid. The only requirement from the rescued families is the return of their capital funds which they personally hand over to the next poor family in need. In addition, these funds are gradually paid into the bank in installments after their own businesses have grown and they are able to sustain their families.

Throughout our stay in Benin City, we visited the various business centers that LYNRMII established. We interviewed the families who received the micro-loans and assessed the progress and growth of their businesses. Many of these families were very satisfied with their business growth and profits. In addition, they were very grateful and referred to Love Your Neighbor Rescue Mission Int. as angel sent by God to deliver them from their predicaments.







NEW BUSINESSES IN JULY 2023

During this mission trip, two new families were also rescued. One was a woman from a family of four whom we established chicken/turkey poultry for in 2019 and now she expanded her farming with one hundred and fifty thousand naira (₹150,000.00) for the addition of goat farming to her business.











The second person was a man that is recovering from stroke whom we rescued with five hundred thousand naira (₹500,000.00) for selling clothes and curtain fabrics.

Love Your Neighbor Farm Project

Love Your Neighbor Farmland is in Urgent need of:

June/July 2023

We visited our farmland of plantain plantation and palm plantation. We drove through the bush of ungraded and unpaved roads to access our farmland of 25 acres of land. A bulldozer created a road to and around the farm. However, rainy season created deep, mudded roads, trapping our transport vehicle. We walked 1.5 miles to the farm for the remaining 10 days and transporting crops by hand.

- 1. Building 3 farm huts within the farm settlement where our rescued farmers and LYNRMII's farm workers need to stay to attend to the crops.
- 2. Building a borehole system to supply water for the farmers who live within the farm settlement. The borehole system is the only feasible way to get water to the farmers.
- 3. The purchase of a pickup truck with offroad tires to navigate the graded, deep rutted, muddy farm roads:
 - a. Provides transportation for the farmers and equipment from the city to the farm, and back.
